

If you have a New Year's resolution to be less sad on your list, strike it out right now. I've heard people say they are going to quit grieving at the beginning of the year only to have this resolution fall flat on its face.

New Year's simply looks different for those who are grieving. You may find yourself more alone than ever as you watch your friends and loved ones carry on celebrating and making resolutions to embrace the year ahead.

When you're grieving there is a sad feeling that comes with the passing of time, and nothing feels like more of a reminder of this than the new year.

Allow grief to be part of our new year. Be kind to yourself. Whether this is your first year without your loved one or whether it's been many years since your loss it's important to honor your feelings and give yourself the time you need to grieve. There will be other years when you feel like celebrating again, but his year be gentle with yourself. So many of us are afraid to feel all the big emotions that come after a loss. These feelings can be overwhelming and make you feel like you're not functioning like everyone else around you, but let that be okay for now. 

Communion Distribution Guidelines

The presider's line will allow people to receive in the hand or on the tongue without discrimination of order. Going forward there will be an Extraordinary Eucharistic minister assigned to distribute communion on the <u>hand only</u> so that those who are concerned about receiving Communion after someone who might have received on the tongue can be at ease. There will not be an additional minister at daily Masses. In the event that there is someone at daily Mass concerned about this, they are encouraged to step forward and receive first. There are no servers at daily Mass, so they would be the first. **Fr.** Will Catholic Charities Case Management team has expanded its services within Dodge County; with this expansion we can reach individuals and families that might be facing various challenges and hardships.
