Hospitality Prayer Formation Service

These four pillars are the foundations of a solid structure. Without any one of the Pillars, the structure will lose stability and risk toppling. When we foster the growth and exercise of each Pillar, we will be building a solid foundation on which Christ can build His Church.

Prayer – The pillar of strength in Stewardship

Words from Father Onildo

Dear friends,

It gives me great joy to greet you through these lines, God first, in time we will get to know each other better. In this opportunity I want to introduce myself so that you know some things about me.

My name is Onildo Orellana Díaz. I was born in Chiquimula, Guatemala on September 19, 1975. I am the second of three children. I have an older sister and a younger brother. I grew up in a very religious home. Since I was a child, my parents taught me to pray and to participate in the life of the Church. This is how the desire to do something important and special with my life is born in me.

In 1994 I began my training at the Major Seminary of the Missionary Fraternity of Mary, in Guatemala City. In January 2000 I was sent to Kenya-Africa, where I was ordained a priest on December 8 of the same year. I stayed in Kenya for only two years. In 2002 I was sent to the mission in Italy, where I stayed for 17 years. The last two years (2020 and 2021), I was in Guatemala waiting for the Visa to be able to join the mission of the Missionary Fraternity of Mary in the United States.

I am very happy to be among you to walk together on the path of Christian life. I know that you helped Father Erick a lot in his pastoral ministry with you and from what I have read, you have also collaborated a lot with Father Sergio.

I thank God for granting me the possibility of living a new missionary experience. I thank the Archdiocese of Milwaukee for allowing me to exercise my priestly ministry with all of you and naturally, I also thank Father Will for his openness to the pastoral collaboration that the Missionary Fraternity of Mary offers him.

From the moment I knew I would come to serve you, I have kept you present in my prayers and they will always be. As far as I can help you, always count on me. With the help of God and with the intercession of our Blessed Mother, we will achieve together to build the Kingdom of God.

May God's blessing be with you every day of this new year.




