



## **Words from Father Will**

Dear friends,

Recently, we celebrated the Epiphany of the Lord. Although it was just a few weeks back, it seems so long ago. In the Gospel from Matthew we heard about how the magi traveled a great distance from the East in search of the newborn king. The magi show us that God took on flesh for not a select few, but the entire world. They highlight God's invitation to all humanity in a new covenant through the Incarnation. This past Tuesday, January 18<sup>th</sup>, we began the Week of Prayer for Christian Unity. It concludes on Tuesday, January 25<sup>th</sup>. Although the Roman Catholic Church, Orthodox, and Protestant churches may differ on various theological topics, there is indeed a common ground in which we can come together in prayer. Certainly, the pandemic is one cross that we've all carried for some time now. Beyond this cross, there are extremely difficult and disastrous situations throughout the world that call us to a unity as the Body of Christ. Through the power of prayer we can demonstrate the Christian unity to which Christ calls us and remain in solidarity with those who carry heavy burdens in places of violence, famine, and disaster. Though many parts, we are one body. As one body, may we be more focused on Christ, our Head.

Closer to home, we remember every January 22<sup>nd</sup>, a Day of Prayer for the Legal Protection of Unborn Children. Since the U.S. Supreme Court's 1973 decision in *Roe v. Wade*, over 60 million children have been robbed of the gift and right to life. Disguised as beneficial, this disgraceful legislation allowing legal abortion has cast a dark shadow over our nation and the entire world. The Holy Father has stated that these children bear the face of Jesus Christ. To secure peace and security in our world, we must see the face of Christ in each other which calls us to a deeper honor and respect for the sacredness of all human life. I would like to take a moment to offer my appreciation for the Pregnancy Support Center of Dodge County located in Beaver Dam. In their commitment to upholding the dignity and value of the unborn, men and women from the area go to great lengths to support mothers and their babies in times of distress. I encourage everyone to get to know this organization and the wonderful work that they quietly perform on a daily basis.

Recientemente, celebramos la Epifanía del Señor. Aunque fue hace solo unas semanas, parece que fue hace mucho tiempo. En el Evangelio de Mateo escuchamos cómo los magos viajaron una gran distancia desde Oriente en busca del rey recién nacido. Los magos nos muestran que Dios se hizo carne no para unos pocos elegidos, sino para todo el mundo. Destacan la invitación de Dios a toda la humanidad en una nueva alianza a través de la Encarnación. El pasado martes 18 de enero comenzamos la Semana de Oración por la Unidad de los Cristianos. Concluye el martes 25 de enero. Aunque la Iglesia católica romana, las iglesias ortodoxa y protestante pueden diferir en varios temas teológicos, de hecho hay un terreno común en el que podemos unirnos en oración. Ciertamente, la pandemia es una cruz que todos cargamos desde hace algún tiempo. Más allá de esta cruz, existen situaciones extremadamente difíciles y desastrosas en todo el mundo que nos llaman a la unidad como Cuerpo de Cristo. A través del poder de la oración podemos demostrar la unidad cristiana a la que Cristo nos llama y permanecer en solidaridad con aquellos que llevan pesadas cargas en lugares de violencia, hambruna y desastre. Aunque muchas partes, somos un solo cuerpo. Como un solo cuerpo, que estemos más enfocados en Cristo, nuestra Cabeza.

Más cerca de casa, recordamos cada 22 de enero una Jornada de Oración por la Protección Jurídica del Niño por Nacer. Desde la decisión de la Corte Suprema de los EE. UU. en 1973 en Roe v. Para asegurar la paz y la seguridad en nuestro mundo, debemos ver el rostro de Cristo en los demás, lo que nos llama a un mayor honor y respeto por la santidad de toda vida humana. Quisiera tomarme un momento para expresar mi agradecimiento por el Centro de apovo para el embarazo del condado de Dodge ubicado en Beaver Dam. Prayer Helpers: Type out the words or phrases of a common Prayer (The Lord's Pray, Hail Mary, Act of Contrition...) on Labels. Place labels on Lego Pieces and have your children build something with the phrases in order

## **Encourage Mass as a Dialogue/Prayer to Jesus**

Encouraging "Full and Active Participation" begins with us responding to some common phrases used in Mass.

**Prayer Responses:** Think about the dialogue in Mass. Use the Gather book in our pews for some help too. Cut out strips of paper and write down sayings and responses (one set for sayings, and one set for our response) "The Lord be with you... and with your Spirit" "Lamb of God... You take away the sins of the World" Lord I am not Worth that I should enter under your roof ... but only say the word and I shall be healed..."

Turn the strips upside down and have your family match them. Then, when you go to Mass, the responses will come naturally. As Mass begins, point out to your children and model them as a family. Ask them to pay attention to when they hear them and talk after Mass!

#### Queridos hermanos en Cristo Jesús:

Mi nombre es Rosalía Villalba y el día de hoy les presento el maravilloso tema del significado de la paciencia desde el punto de vista cristiano de la Iglesia Católica.



Escribe santa Teresa de Ávila que "la paciencia todo lo alcanza".

Sin embargo, en la sociedad actual es todo un reto ser pacientes ya que ésta se mueve a una velocidad vertiginosa; se vive la "cultura de la inmediatez", en la cual lo que importa es la rapidez y la satisfacción instantánea. Todo es velocidad y ansiedad.

La paciencia es la más heroica de las virtudes, precisamente porque carece de toda apariencia de heroísmo". La paciencia no es resignación, inactividad o indiferencia, sino constancia, insistencia y coherencia; por tanto, es una forma de acción que convive con la espera.

La paciencia inicia reconociendo que hay que saber contenerse y esperar para recoger mejores frutos.

Desde el punto de vista cristiano, apunta el Catecismo de la Iglesia Católica, una consecuencia de la fe "es confiar en Dios en todas las circunstancias, incluso en la adversidad. Una oración de santa Teresa de Jesús lo expresa admirablemente: 'Nada te turbe, / nada te espante,/ todo se pasa, / Dios no se muda./ La paciencia / todo lo alcanza;/ quien a Dios tiene / nada le falta: Sólo Dios basta'" (n. 227).

Más aún, además de una virtud, para la Iglesia la paciencia es también uno de los doce frutos del Espíritu Santo. conforme a lo que dice Gálatas 5, 22-25..

Los frutos del Espíritu Santo son perfecciones en un individuo como primicias de la gloria eterna. La paciencia lo hará mantenerse constante y soportar las situaciones difíciles de la vida. De hecho, la constancia es siempre clave en toda vida cristiana.
