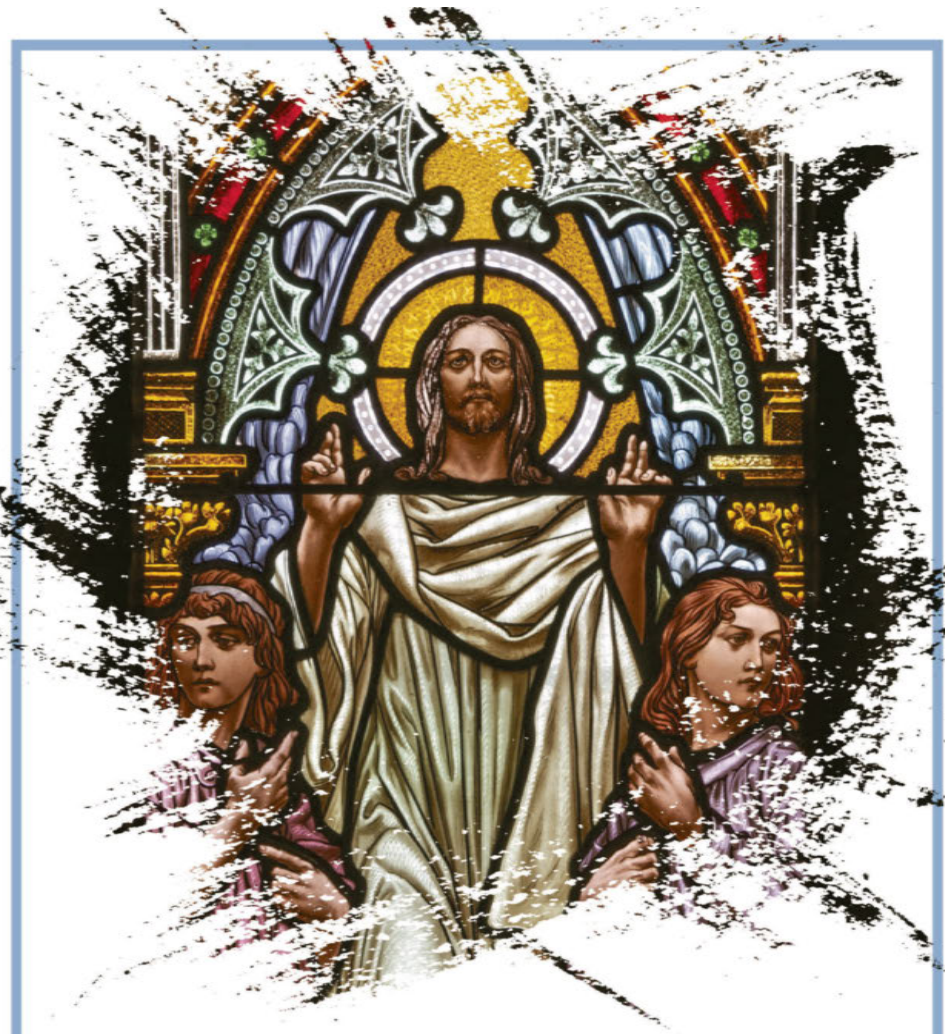

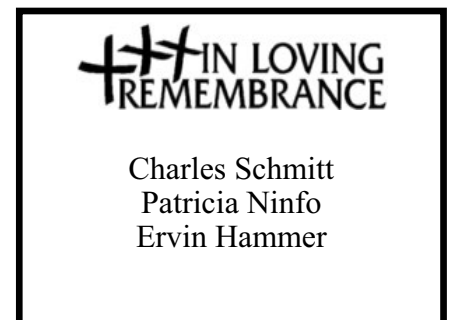

Words from Father Onildo

Dear friends,

This time I want to remind you that on the third Sunday of ordinary time, (this year on January 23), the Church celebrates the Sunday of the Word of God. Pope Francis instituted this Day on September 30, 2019, in order to dedicate a Sunday completely to the Word of God.

On the Sunday dedicated to the reflection and celebration of the Word of God, Pope Francis underlines its value: alive and effective, it enlightens, comforts and orders our daily activities. But it is also a beacon that guides the synodal path begun in the Church.

The Pontiff proposes this Sunday dedicated to the celebration, reflection and dissemination of the Word of God:

To understand the richness that comes from that constant dialogue between God and his people.

For the Church to revive the gesture of the Risen One who also opens for us the treasure of his Word so that we can announce this inexhaustible richness throughout the world.

So that the decisive relationship with the living Word that the Lord never tires of directing to his Bride will never be lacking, so that he can grow in love and in the testimony of faith.

In addition, the celebration has been made to coincide with the Week of Prayer for Christian Unity. A time "in which we are invited to strengthen the bonds of friendship with the Jews and to pray for the unity of Christians. It is not a mere coincidence of time: celebrating the Sunday of the Word of God expresses an ecumenical value, because Sacred Scripture indicates to those who are listening the path to follow to reach an authentic and solid unity».

Let us welcome Pope Francis' invitation to read a page of the Gospel every day and with time we will realize that those words are made for us, for our lives. They will help us to welcome each day with a better, more serene look, because when the Gospel enters our life, it fills it with God.

Esta vez quiero recordarles que el tercer domingo del tiempo ordinario, (este año el 23 de enero), la Iglesia celebra el Domingo de la Palabra de Dios. Papa Francisco instituyó esta Jornada el 30 de septiembre de 2019, con el fin de dedicar un domingo completamente a la Palabra de Dios.

En el domingo dedicado a la reflexión y celebración de la Palabra de Dios, Papa Francisco subraya su valor: viva y eficaz, ella ilumina, consuela y ordena nuestras actividades diarias. Pero también es un faro que guía el camino sinodal iniciado en la Iglesia.

El Pontífice propone este Domingo **dedicado a la celebración, reflexión y divulgación de la Palabra de Dios:**

Para comprender la riqueza que proviene de ese diálogo constante de Dios con su pueblo.

Para que la Iglesia reviva el gesto del Resucitado que abre también para nosotros el tesoro de su Palabra para que podamos anunciar por todo el mundo esta riqueza inagotable.

Para que nunca falte la relación decisiva con la Palabra viva que el Señor nunca se cansa de dirigir a su Esposa, para que pueda crecer en el amor y en el testimonio de fe.

Además, la celebración se ha hecho coincidir con la **Semana de Oración por la Unidad de los Cristianos**. Un tiempo «en el que estamos invitados a fortalecer los lazos de amistad con los judíos y a rezar por la unidad de los cristianos. No se trata de una mera coincidencia temporal: celebrar el *Domingo de la Palabra de Dios* expresa un valor ecuménico, porque la Sagrada Escritura indica a los que se ponen en actitud de escucha el camino a seguir para llegar a una auténtica y sólida unidad».

Acojamos la invitación de Papa Francisco a leer todos los días una página del Evangelio y con el tiempo nos daremos cuenta que esas palabras están hechas para nosotros, para nuestra vida. Nos ayudaran a acoger cada día, con una mirada mejor, más serena, porque cuando el Evangelio entra en nuestra vida, la llena de Dios.

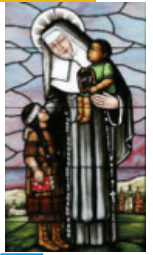

Mi nombre es Rosalía Villalba y el día de hoy les hablaré acerca de la Misión del Catequista.



Nuestro Santo Padre, Papa Francisco reconoce la labor de los catequistas dentro de la Iglesia, diciendo: “Ellos tienen una misión insustituible en la transmisión y profundización de la fe”, y les expresa su agradecimiento: “Damos gracias a los catequistas por el entusiasmo interior con el que viven esta misión al servicio de la Iglesia”.

Papa Francisco destaca que el ministerio del catequista es una verdadera y auténtica vocación en la comunidad cristiana, pone el acento en el ser de este agente de pastoral. “Ser catequista significa que uno es catequista, no que trabaja de catequista”

El 10 de mayo de 2021, con el Motu Proprio, *Antiquum ministerium*, el Papa Francisco instituyó el ministerio de Catequista en la Iglesia católica. El ministerio de Catequista es muy antiguo en la Iglesia, el Nuevo Testamento ofrece múltiples testimonios de este servicio y, por otra parte, la historia de la evangelización muestra la eficacia de la misión de los catequistas.

Obispos, sacerdotes y diáconos, junto con tantos consagrados han dedicado su vida a la enseñanza catequética para que la fe “fuera un apoyo válido para la existencia personal de cada ser humano” (*Antiquum Ministerium*, 3). Esto significa que quienes hemos recibido el don de la fe y hemos profundizado en ella, estamos llamados a catequizar.

El Catequista es al mismo tiempo testigo de la fe, maestro y mistagogo, acompañante y pedagogo que enseña en nombre de la Iglesia. Una identidad que sólo puede desarrollarse con coherencia y responsabilidad mediante la oración, el estudio y la participación directa en la vida de la comunidad” (cf. Pontificio Consejo para la Promoción de la Nueva Evangelización, *Directorio para la Catequesis*, 113)

Desde los primeros siglos del cristianismo han existido innumerables hombres y mujeres que obedientes al Espíritu Santo han contribuido en la formación de la fe. Por medio de la catequesis se sigue un proceso gradual, progresivo, sistemático, organizado, permanente, y continuo en la fe que da solidez y fuerza a cuantos ya han recibido el bautismo.

Son muchos los laicos y laicas que en virtud de su propio bautismo están participando directamente en la difusión del Evangelio a través de la enseñanza de la Catequesis.

Ofrezcamos nuestras oraciones a Dios para la llegada de más Catequistas. Amén.
