


The Lord has blessed us by giving Himself to all of us and he continues to bless us all by the many good works that each one of I you bring to this community.

In November, St. James parishioners donated a total of \$252.00 for window restoration!






St. James parishioners donated \$804.00 to Cornucopia in November.
