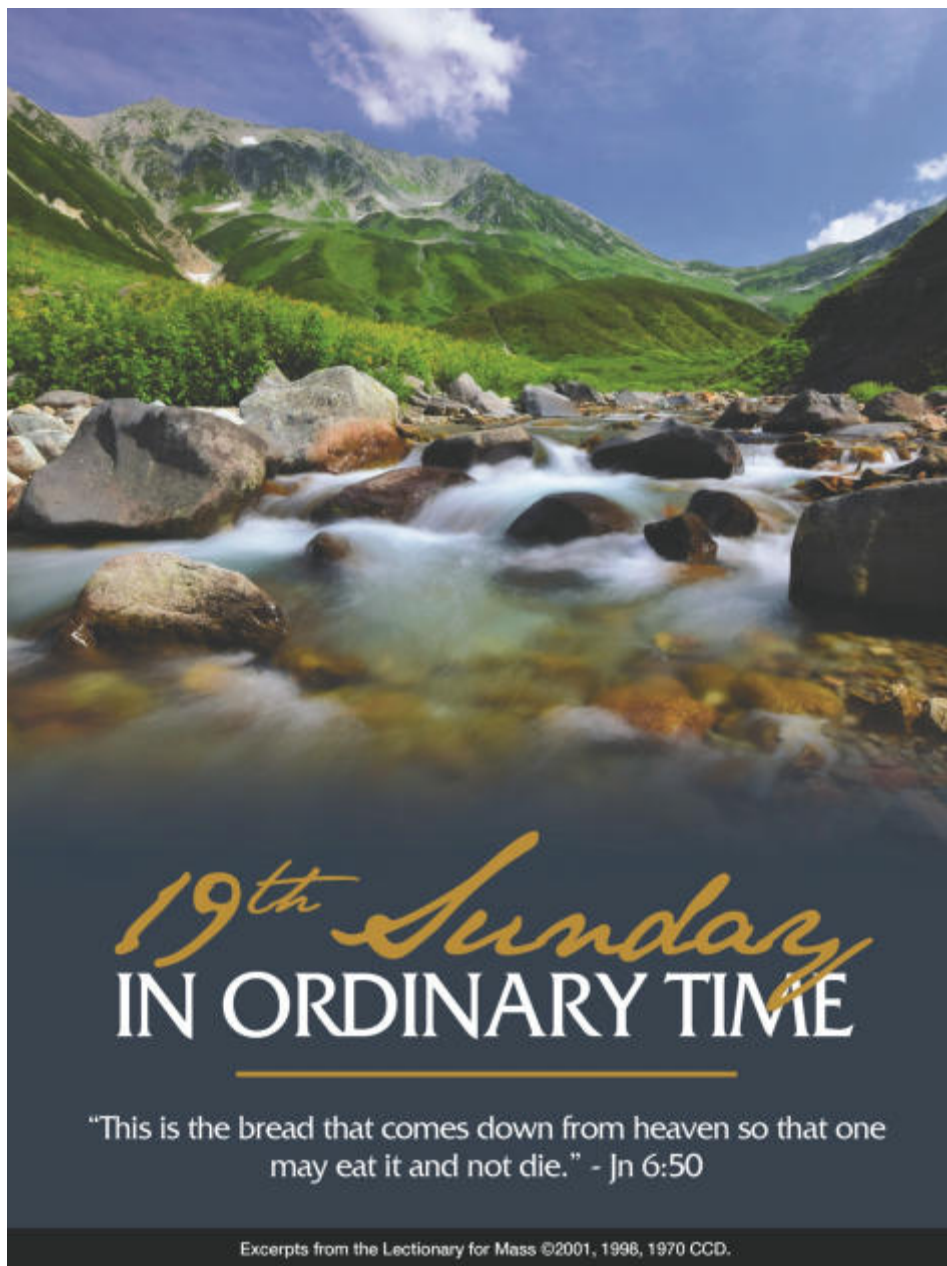

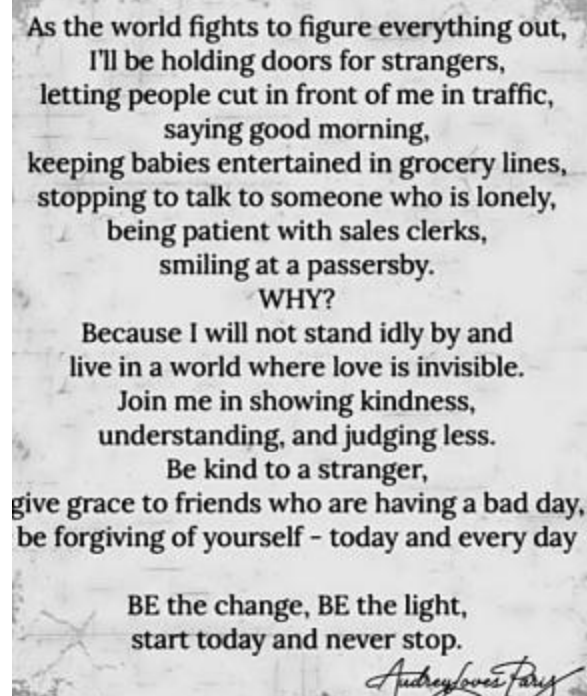
Black Lives Are Sacred

Have you heard of this group? They were formed last year after the killing of George Floyd as a faith based group to “proclaim the sacredness of Black Lives, amplifying Black voices and inspiring people of faith to stand up for racial justice. They provide weekly opportunities throughout the Milwaukee area for “witness demonstrations”. Groups gather, spend a few moments in prayer, grab signs (provided, if needed) and stand along streets and intersections to be a visible sign of support for Black Lives. If participants are able, there is the chance to kneel for 9 minutes in silence and prayer. The Justice and Peace Commission is partnering with Kingdom Prep High School to host a witness demonstration. Please, consider taking time out of your day to join us.

Time: 5:30 - 6:30 pm

Location: Gather in the Pius parking lot. We will stand along both sides of Wauwatosa Avenue. Bring an appropriate sign if you can, but signs will be available.



Health Ministry

Milwaukee County's Aging & Disability Resource Centers to Re-Open to In-Person Services August 2nd

In-person, walk-in services are resuming for older adults and individuals with differing abilities at Milwaukee County's Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS) building, located at 1220 W. Vliet Street, beginning Monday, August 2, 2021. The Aging Resource Center (ARC) and Disability Resource Center (DRC) in the Marcia P. Coggs building will be open during regular business hours, M - F, from 8:00 am to 4:00 pm. The regular business hours for GOPass services are M - F from 9:00 am to 2:00 pm. People seeking services at the Coggs location should go to the Disability Resource Center reception desk on the third floor of the building. In addition to resuming in-person services at the Coggs building, in-person home visits for long-term care functional screenings and in-person options counseling will also resume.

The Aging Division coordinates a variety of social services such as home-delivered meals, family caregiver supports, congregate meals, senior center programming, and other services for older adults in Milwaukee County.

Aging Services that will be available in-person for older adults include:

- Information and Assistance — Accurate and timely information about community resources for older adults.
- Options Counseling — One-on-one consultation about privately and publicly funded long-term care options.
- Elder Benefits -- Information about public and private benefits including Medicare, Medicaid and Social Security.
- Dementia Care Specialists — Information and support for caregivers and people experiencing memory loss.
- Prevention and Wellness — Wellness and prevention workshops to promote healthy living.
- GOPass — Determine eligibility for Milwaukee County reduced bus fare.
- Burial Services — Determine State and County financial eligibility for the deceased funeral expenses.
- Interim Disability Assistance Program

Disability Services that will be available in-person for individuals with disabilities ages 18+ include:

- Information and Assistance — Accurate and timely information regarding community resources for older adults.
- Options Counseling — One-on-one consultation about privately and publicly funded long-term care options.
- Disability Benefits — Information about public and private benefits including Medicare, Medicaid and Social Security.
- Burial Services — Determine State and County financial eligibility for the deceased funeral expenses.
- GOPass — Determine eligibility for Milwaukee County reduced bus fare.
- Adult Protective Services — Confidential investigations of abuse, neglect, self-neglect, and financial exploitation.
- Interim Disability Assistance Program — Determine financial assistance for individuals waiting for Supplemental Security Income (SSI).
- Youth Transition Services — Coordinate transitional services from the Children's System of Care to the Adult System of Care.

A Letter From Fr. Paul

Please remember to mark your calendar and join us for a "Welcome Back" Mass and reception on Sunday, September 12th, beginning with Mass in the church at 10:30 am and then moving to the gym for fellowship and a delicious meal.

Life is a "both-and." Paul gives a very clear example in our reading from Ephesians: we BOTH have to **avoid** certain things AND we have to **do** certain things. Not just avoid sinful behavior but also embrace good behavior. BOTH-AND!

What do we need to avoid? *All bitterness, fury, anger, shouting, and reviling must be removed from you, along with all malice.* Notice the verb "removed." These feelings will come: they are part of being a human being. But we can't buy in to them, allow them to rule us.

What do we need to embrace instead? *Be kind to one another, compassionate, forgiving one another as God has forgiven you in Christ.* Notice the emphasis here: it is on the other person. When we act out of anger or bitterness, we are focused on ourselves. When we can be kind to another, especially when they don't deserve it, when we can be compassionate and forgiving, we are focused on the other.

The irony is that, when we can think of the other person and not just ourselves, we are more at peace. When I am angry and railing against someone or acting out against them, I am not happy. When I can forgive and let go, I am at peace. It is an example of Jesus' saying, "the one who loses his life will find it."

I invite us to reflect on this paradox, asking God to help us "let go" if we are clinging to any bitterness, resentment, or anger. God bless.
