


2<sup>nd</sup> Sunday of Ordinary Time January 16, 2022

One of our evening mass participants is so spiritually drawn to our nativity scene with only the three little lights "on the floor" are

lighted. So, after the evening mass, I experienced such "awesome" quite and serene scene to corroborate such observation. I immediately share the pictures through a text message to one of our parish staff.
