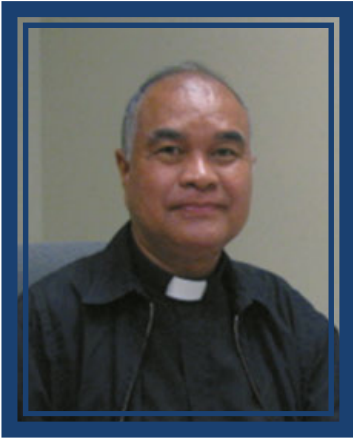

PASTOR'S CORNER

3rd Sunday in Ordinary Time January 23, 2022

Someone asked about ministry fair and if their physical abilities are necessary to serve and I at once replied, yes, but what matters most is the willingness to serve. Involvement in one or two of the parish ministries as listed in our parish bulletin is negotiated by way of the group planning together. 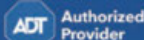
