4th Week of Easter

The involvement of families (back to the 3rd generation) with our First Communion and Baptism celebrations last Sunday manifests intense connections within families. The intensity is un-quantifiable for it is spiritual in nature. We can attribute such nature to our Catholic tradition rooted in words in Jesus as the Good Shepherd. Let His words resound even in those family relations that we find challenging and, at times, irreversible. And let Jesus handle such relations in ways that are His, not ours.

The connections between Jesus and His Father are what we can identify too. Jesus mentions this in the Gospel this Sunday, "nothing can separate" us from His Father for "Jesus gave Himself" for such connection. How rich this is for building up with no other than with Jesus during and after we come to mass and other sacramental celebrations. We endure as His flock, to be a people as His own. This is how the psalmist proclaims it.

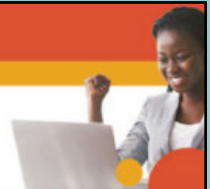
