

In the first two hundred years of Christianity through Tertullian, the word Trinity referring to God, the Father, God the Son, and God the



Holy Spirit appeared. Then expounded by St. Augustine and St. Thomas Aquinas through reasoning from created things. But such reasoning assumes faith to the words of Jesus in the gospels and other books of the New Testament.
