Pastor's Corner



Among my favorite story about Corpus Christi is a procession that took place in a parish during World War II. Everyone at that time was confined to their homes due to fear, but some with the parish priest simply started it, then people followed. They sang songs honoring Jesus as their Savior & King. I suppose this gesture of procession till these days, spark such devotion and love about Jesus among us thru the Eucharist.

The word Eucharist means "good gift" evolved through the centuries with same meaning, that is, Jesus' presence in the Eucharist form. How such presence brings each one like that of Jesus depend on how St. Paul encourages those in Corinth in the second reading today. 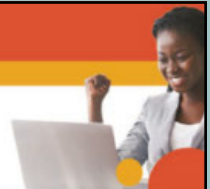
