I was surprised to meet a couple who are long time members of the parish in learning that child rearing is foreign to them for they do not have one. But a double surprise is their smile at me when I asked them if they can adopt me. Days followed that when they willingly accepted my invitation for them to help me in "taking care" of the parish through service in a parish ministry, it dawned on me that, there, they "adopted me." Jesus will not ask something that are "not ours" in following Him. He will always start from where we are.

He asks those whom He chose, "the twelve" from where they are. Their places of work and life are from the "waters" and "land," workers of the earth but leading to a "spiritual kingdom." We can reason out that this rerouting of some of our conversations among family gatherings of the "real and direct" way to follow Jesus. We, at time, are disoriented as disciples/followers of Jesus, when some of our leaders, even mentors in church and society failed or even make us feel betrayed. Let us redirect such emotions/understanding, that it is Jesus, in a more personal ways, whom we follow, and He will not disappoint us.

The conversations of Elijah and Elisha with the corresponding actions that follow between them are ways for us to redirect our thoughts and actions through our summer 2022 gatherings. The clarifications of St. Paul about spiritual values with our "flesh" may purify further our ways towards others and our own "self-care" efforts.

Archdiocese of Kumasi, in Ghana (West Africa), was established in 1950. The Archdiocese of Kumasi has a population of about 605,000 people, half living in rural settings. The work of evangelization takes many forms and continues through the generous support of Catholics worldwide. The Archdiocese of Kumasi has seen significant increases in infant and adult baptisms, Holy Matrimonies and Vocations to the Priesthood and Religious life. The contributions we receive from around the world have been a contributing factor to this.

The Church's healing ministry and efforts in primary evangelization becomes evident through projects aimed at improving the health and well-being of people such as, the building and upgrading of health clinics in deprived areas of the Archdiocese, the care for street children and providing accessible, clean drinking water by building new wells and boreholes, especially on school grounds.

Contributions received also benefit St. Gregory the Great Major Seminary. The generous contributions we have received have helped give rise to an increase of vocations to the priesthood and religious life in the Archdiocese.

Archbishop Gabriel Anoyke expresses his gratitude in anticipation for the generosity and kind support from Your Parish. He acknowledges that the generosity of American Catholics has immensely improved the conditions of many people of Kumasi and has aided the growth of the Church in Africa as a whole.

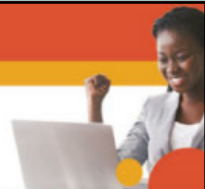
