Pastor's Corner

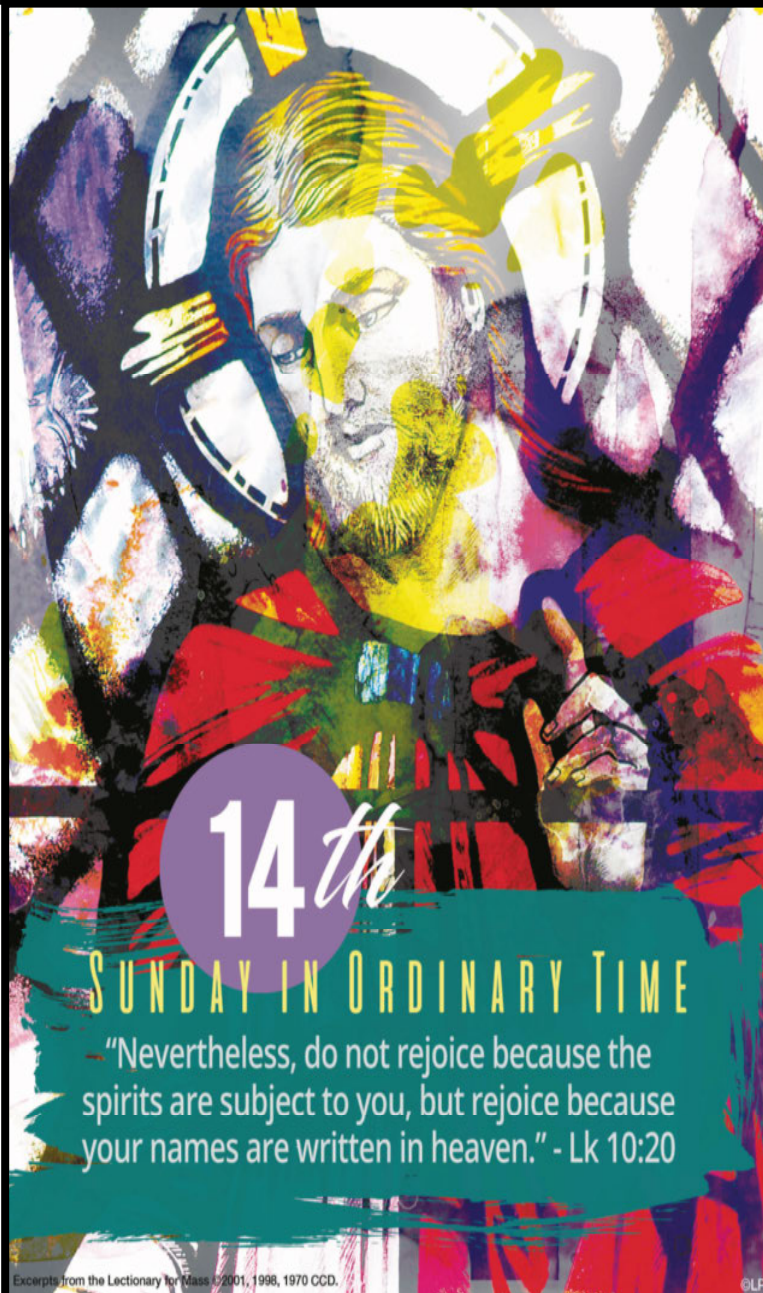
