Pastor's Corner

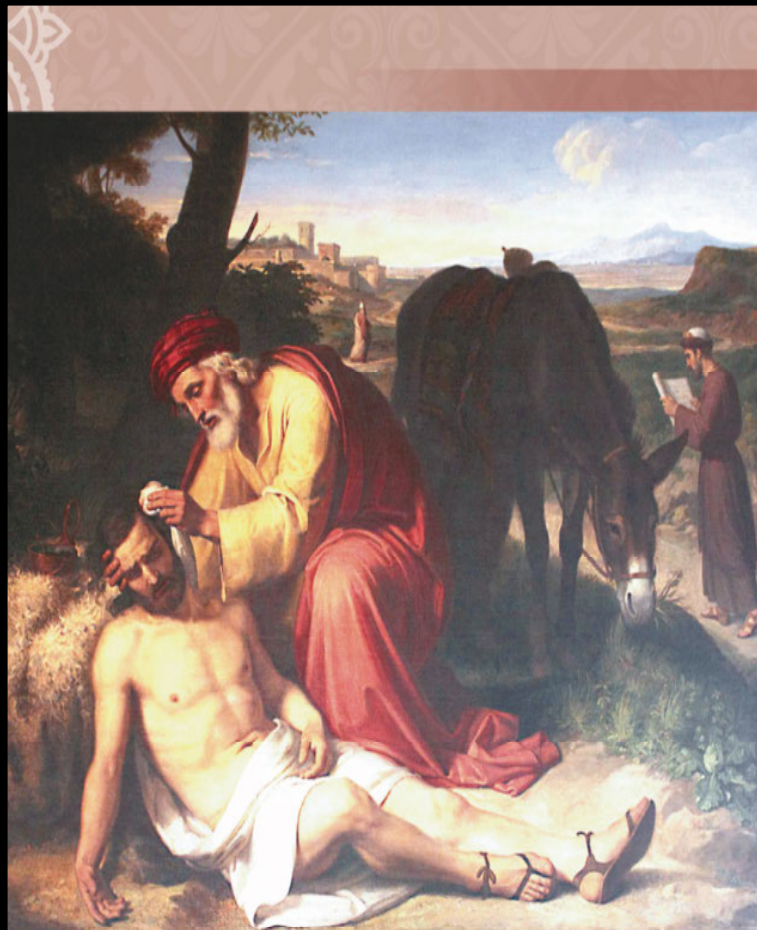

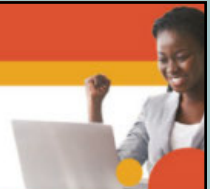
