

## A Message From Our Pastor

**Stewardship Corner:** “Prepare the way of the Lord...” - MARK 1:3 - We are all called to live a holy life. We are all called to invite others to live holy lives. Living a stewardship lifestyle, being grateful and generous with our gifts, puts us on the path to holiness and is an example for others to be holy, too. We are responsible not only for our own lives, but for the lives of others as well.

**Janesville Parishes Advent Communal Penance:** The Janesville cluster of parishes will hold the Advent Communal Penance Service this coming **Wednesday, December 9 at 6:15 PM at St. Patrick Parish.** All the Janesville area priests will be there to help hear individual confessions and absolution of sins. Please plan to attend one of the two Communal Penance services. The next one will be at **Nativity of Mary at 9:30 AM on Saturday, December 19.** In addition, we have Confessions here at SJV, every Saturday from 9:00 – 10 AM and 4:30-4:50PM, before Mass. I encourage everyone to avail themselves of these opportunity for grace as we make preparation for the coming of Christ at Christmas.

**Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception of Mary: A Holy Day of Obligation:** Tuesday December 8, 2020 is the Solemnity of “Maria Immaculata” and a day that Catholics are required to attend Mass. The doctrine of the Immaculate Conception of Mary teaches that “*The Blessed Virgin Mary was preserved, in the first instant of her conception, by a singular grace and privilege of God omnipotent and because of the merits of Jesus Christ the Savior of the human race, free from all stain of original sin*” (Dogma of the Immaculate Conception, Pope Pius IX, December 8, 1954) This means Mary was conceived in the state of perfect justice, free from original sin, and all its consequences and penalties, in virtue of the redemption won by Christ on the cross. In this sense, the privilege of the Immaculate Conception was the anticipated fruit of Christ’s saving passion, death, and resurrection (See *Immaculate Conception, Our Sunday Visitor’s Catholic Encyclopedia*, p. 497). While the first Eve’s response was to go against the will of God, the second Eve (Mary) said “I am the handmaid of the Lord; let it be done to me according to Your word”. The first Eve passed on a fallen human nature to her descendants. Mary passed on Jesus the Savior of the human race. Because of Mary’s special role as the Mother of God’s Son, the Church believes and teaches that she was the first to be saved by the grace of that Son. Mary was above all the one who heard the word of God and heeded it. Her yes to God gives us hope. It

teaches us that God does not force us but allows us freely to respond to the invitation of grace. *We will have Mass at SJV at 8:15 AM (School Mass with limited seating) and 5:15 PM.*

**2<sup>nd</sup> Sunday of Advent Kerygma: Why is everything so obviously messed up?** It’s not fun to talk about sin, but we have to ask ourselves: If God is so good, and so powerful, and if His original plan in creating us was for us to live in perfect harmony and friendship with God and with each other, then *why on earth [or literally why in hell] is everything so obviously messed up?* The Good News of the Gospel begins with Christmas. But to appreciate how good the Good News is, we must hear the bad news first. God is perfectly good, but one of the creatures He made chose to rebel against God. That creature is our enemy, Satan.

Satan is not an equal rival to God. He is just a creature. Why did he rebel against God? In Wisdom 2:24, it says that it was “through the devil’s *envy* that death entered the world, and those who belong to his party experience it.” Who is he envious of? *You*. Why is he envious of us? Because he saw in God’s plan for creation, that he, an incredibly powerful angel, would have to serve us lowly human beings. He saw the happiness that God planned for us and he resented it. So, what did he do? Go to war against God? No. He knows he cannot touch God; he is just a creature. So, he went to war against the creature that God loves most: *us*. What is his goal? To enslave, humiliate, and destroy you. From the beginning of the human race, his goal has been to enslave those he was meant to serve and to humiliate and degrade those whom God had created for such an exalted destiny. What is his strategy? To convince us that God is not a loving Father; and that we can be happy without God. What are his tactics? He accuses, lies, divides, flatters, tempts, and discourages.

But we do have Hope because Christ has come to rescue us. That is what Christmas is all about. In the first reading today, we hear God telling the prophet Isaiah to “give comfort to My people.” Tell them that their “service is at an end.” For behold, God is coming. “Here is your God! The Lord God comes with power.” (The inspiration for this series was taken from the book by Fr. John Riccardo, *Rescued: The Unexpected and Extraordinary News of the Gospel* (Word Among Us, 2020),

## Readings for Next Weekend

### First Reading

#### Isaiah 61:1-2A, 10-11

The spirit of the Lord GOD is upon me, because the LORD has anointed me; he has sent me to bring glad tidings to the poor, to heal the brokenhearted, to proclaim liberty to the captives and release to the prisoners, to announce a year of favor from the LORD and a day of vindication by our God. I rejoice heartily in the LORD, in my God is the joy of my soul; for he has clothed me with a robe of salvation and wrapped me in a mantle of justice, like a bridegroom adorned with a diadem, like a bride bedecked with her jewels. As the earth brings forth its plants, and a garden makes its growth spring up, so will the Lord GOD make justice and praise spring up before all the nations.

### Second Reading

#### 1 Thessalonians 5:16-24

Rejoice always. Pray without ceasing. In all circumstances give thanks, for this is the will of God for you in Christ Jesus. Do not quench the Spirit. Do not despise prophetic utterances. Test everything; retain what is good. Refrain from every kind of evil. May the God of peace make you perfectly holy and may you entirely, spirit, soul, and body, be preserved blameless for the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ. The one who calls you is faithful, and he will also accomplish it.

### Gospel

#### John 1:6-8, 19-28

A man named John was sent from God. He came for testimony, to testify to the light, so that all might believe through him. He was not the light, but came to testify to the light. And this is the testimony of John. When the Jews from Jerusalem sent priests and Levites to him to ask him, "Who are you?" He admitted and did not deny it, but admitted, "I am not the Christ." So they asked him, "What are you then? Are you Elijah?" And he said, "I am not." "Are you the Prophet?" He answered, "No." So they said to him, "Who are you, so we can give an answer to those who sent us? What do you have to say for yourself?" He said: "I am *the voice of one crying out in the desert, 'make straight the way of the Lord,'*"

as Isaiah the prophet said." Some Pharisees were also sent. They asked him, "Why then do you baptize if you are not the Christ or Elijah or the Prophet?" John answered them, "I baptize with water; but there is one among you whom you do not recognize, the one who is coming after me, whose sandal strap I am not worthy to untie." This happened in Bethany across the Jordan, where John was baptizing.

## CCW African Sewing Project Update



Thankfully the restrictions on shipping to South Africa were lightened just lately. I was finally able to ship all the items we created this year to Solwezi--8 large boxes. We send these to the Catholic Diocese of Solwezi and they are distributed through them to those in great need.

Wonder what was in those boxes? We sent: 300 dresses with shoulder ties, 20 t-shirt dresses, 78 shorts, 12 afghans, and 24 receiving blankets and quilts. These were created by ladies of the parish and friends from the area who joined us in this project. Thanks to everyone who donated

their time to crochet and sew the gorgeous items, create bias tape and collect fabric, thread and notions. Thanks also for the monetary donations we received to purchase other items needed and toward shipping.

Well, shipping to Solwezi, Zambia, South Africa is not a bargain. The cost to ship everything made the postal workers wonder about my sanity and offer all types of suggestions--none of which would work for me, I had already checked them. They need the blankets and clothing there, not here. The total of to ship those 8 boxes was \$1428.50. CCW had budgeted some of that amount expecting to make more money when we held the rummage sale. No surprise to you, due to the pandemic, we couldn't have the fundraiser.

Can you help us fully fund this project? If everyone in the parish could donate even \$1 it would help tremendously. Thanks for considering helping us keep this project running--this was my tenth year to chair this project and support the children in Solwezi and it would be nice to continue.


