

**The Solemnity of the Assumption of Mary:** The dogma of the Assumption states that Mary was taken up body and soul into heaven after the completion of her earthly life, since by reason of her Immaculate Conception she should not suffer the consequence of original sin – death. Writing on the Assumption, the Fathers of the Second Vatican Council wrote: “Finally the Immaculate Virgin, preserved free from all stain of original sin, was taken up body and soul into heavenly glory, when her earthly life was over, and exalted by the Lord as Queen over all things, that she might be more fully conformed to her Son, the Lord of lords and Conqueror of sin and death” (Lumen Gentium n. 59). It is important to point out that we Catholics worship God alone, but we honor Mary as the ever-virgin Mother of God. We ask for her intercession because of

the special place she holds in our faith. Since it pleases God to make Mary the sinless virgin, we the people of God must not fail to honor her as the first disciple of Jesus her Son. Can anyone truly love God and care less about His Mother? Ave Maria!

## From the Desk of the Principal

Dear Members of the SJV Parish and School Families,

We welcome you to this weekend's celebration of Catholic schools. Following Mass this weekend you will see excited families picking up their back-to-school packets and shopping through the shared uniforms in the Gathering Space. We are excited to begin the school year, and we welcome many new families to our SJV family. This weekend we welcome you to learn more about St. John Vianney Catholic School and about the quality education your support provides for our students.

According to the People's Alliance for Continuing Education (PACE), "Catholic education is very active in teaching a child that God is in their life and all around him or her. A child will learn how to see these "footprints of God" in their daily lives." This is such a moving statement. We often speak of our footprint on this beautiful Earth, but Catholic schools weave an appreciation for God walking with us. During these trying times, we find that aspect of Catholic education is valued above all. Catholic schools welcome students to pray for each other and those in the community.

A study conducted by a non-Catholic source, "... indicated that students from Catholic education ranked highest in terms of participating in community and civic engagement. This could mean highest in terms of charity donations, writing to legislators, volunteering, and voting". Our vision at St. John Vianney Catholic School is "Learn. Pray. Serve". It is in this weaving of our Catholic responsibility to be stewards that we cultivate a culture of community service and leadership to share the grace we have been given. All of our students at SJV are well practiced in public speaking and are encouraged to become members of our Advisory Board, a middle school committee working with area catholic schools to organize faith-filled philanthropic events throughout the year.

Our own academic achievement is evident by the scores of sixty-eight and seventy-two percent of our students are proficient in math and reading versus thirty-six and thirty-nine percent in the school district. The difference in Catholic education is the safe environment we provide to allow children to focus on these academics and the opportunity for prayer to give thanks and ask for support when needed. We are a family rooted in the Church, and our parents treat it as such with a strong school/

Please welcome the new families to our SJV family and thank our returning and past parents who have made the commitment to Catholic education. Readings for Next Weekend

First Reading

**Joshua 24:1-2a, 15-17, 18b**

Joshua gathered together all the tribes of Israel at Shechem, summoning their elders, their leaders, their judges, and their officers. When they stood in ranks before God, Joshua addressed all the people: “If it does not please you to serve the LORD, decide today whom you will serve, the gods your fathers served beyond the River or the gods of the Amorites in whose country you are now dwelling. As for me and my household, we will serve the LORD.”

But the people answered, “Far be it from us to forsake the LORD for the service of other gods. For it was the LORD, our God, who brought us and our fathers up out of the land of Egypt, out of a state of slavery. He performed those great miracles before our very eyes and protected us along our entire journey and among the peoples through whom we passed. Therefore we also will serve the LORD, for he is our God.”

Second Reading

**Ephesians 5:21-32**

Brothers and sisters: Be subordinate to one another out of reverence for Christ. Wives should be subordinate to their husbands as to the Lord. For the husband is head of his wife just as Christ is head of the church, he himself the savior of the body. As the church is subordinate to Christ, so wives should be subordinate to their husbands in everything. Husbands, love your wives, even as Christ loved the church and handed himself over for her to sanctify her, cleansing her by the bath of water with the word, that he might present to himself the church in splendor, without spot or wrinkle or any such thing, that she might be holy and without blemish. So also husbands should love their wives as their own bodies. He who loves his wife loves himself. For no one hates his own flesh but rather nourishes and cherishes it, even as Christ does the church, because we are members of his body. *For this reason a man shall leave his father and his mother and be joined to his wife, and the two shall become one flesh.* This is a great mystery, but I speak in reference to Christ and the church.

Gospel

**John 6:60-69**

Many of Jesus’ disciples who were listening said, “This saying is hard; who can accept it?” Since Jesus knew that his disciples were murmuring about this, he said to them, “Does this shock you? What if you were to see the Son of Man ascending to where he was before? It is the spirit that gives life, while the flesh is of no avail. The words I have spoken to you are Spirit and life. But there are some of you who do not believe.” Jesus knew from the beginning the ones who would not believe and the one who would betray him. And he said, “For this reason I have told you that no one can come to me unless it is granted him by my Father.”

As a result of this, many of his disciples returned to their former way of life and no longer accompanied him. Jesus then said to the Twelve, “Do you also want to leave?” Simon Peter answered him, “Master, to whom shall we go? You have the words of eternal life. We have come to believe and are convinced that you are the Holy One of God.”
