

#### **PRO-LIFE**

#### BIDEN ADMINISTRATION SUES TEXAS TO BLOCK ITS HEARTBEAT LAW

The Biden administration has sued the state of Texas over its new law banning most abortions when a fetal heartbeat can be detected, usually around six weeks. The Department of Justice suit seeks a permanent injunction on state officials and private individuals from implementing or enforcing the law. The Texas law requires doctors to check for a fetal heartbeat before performing an abortion and prohibits most abortions if a heartbeat is found. Though courts have blocked similar heartbeat bills - including Missouri's HB 126 - from going into effect, Texas legislators wrote their bill to avoid a pre-enforcement challenge. Instead of giving the state enforcement authority, the law allows private individuals to bring civil suits against those who perform illegal abortions, and anyone who "knowingly" aids and abets an illegal abortion. The U.S. Supreme Court last week declined to block the bill, citing the fact that the abortion providers bringing suit did not name a proper defendant.

Archbishop Joseph F. Naumann, chairman of the USCCB Committee on Pro-Life Activities, issued a statement on Texas' efforts to support pregnant and new mothers. Naumann praised the Texas legislature for increasing support for low-income mothers by 25 percent through the state's Alternatives to Abortion program, and for expanding Medicaid coverage for new mothers. Archbishop Naumann also expressed disappointment with efforts to block the Texas heartbeat bill. "Tragically, the President, Speaker of the House, and other public officials have responded with statements that ignore our nation's sacred interest to protect the life and health of both mothers and their unborn children, instead responding with radical pledges to mobilize the full force of the federal government to block all efforts to protect the life of the child in the womb," Naumann said. He also highlighted the USCCB initiative, Walking with Moms in Need, which seeks to "[surround] both mother and her child with love and practical support as the humane response to a difficult pregnancy."

#### TELL CONGRESS: "HUMAN INFRASTRUCTURE" MUST NOT FUND ABORTION!

There's another huge battle shaping up in Congress over taxpayer funding of abortion, and the U.S. Conference of Catholic Bishops is asking for your help. As you know, the USCCB is fighting to preserve the Hyde Amendment in government spending. The Hyde Amendment protects Americans from being forced to pay for abortion with our tax dollars.

But the House and Senate are moving forward on a "human infrastructure" bill. The bill is likely to include things that many Catholics support, including expanded health care coverage. But there is serious concern that such health care proposals will fund elective abortion.

Democratic leadership is using a rare process known as "budget reconciliation", which would allow this "human infrastructure" bill to become law with a simple majority vote (most legislation requires 60 votes in the Senate to move forward).

That is why we need your voice NOW to tell Congress that Americans do NOT want their tax dollars to pay for abortions in ANY bill, much less a bill promoted as a "human infrastructure" bill.
