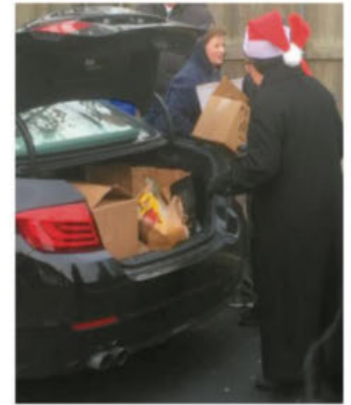

ATTENTION SAINT CLEMENT OF ROME SHARPSHOOTERS!

It's that time of year again for the **Knights of Columbus Free Throw Competition!** The competition is 100% FREE and all boys and girls ages 9-14 in the parish are eligible.

However, like most events over the last two years, we will need to handle a bit differently...this year's competition will be VIRTUAL. I ask that all participants video themselves and email/text to me with their results.

The challenge is straightforward – essentially, the goal is to make as many free throws as possible in 15 attempts. The boy & girl of each age group with most baskets wins the Council level of competition, receives a brand new basketball, and advances to the District level which will be held on February 20th (usually hosted by St Monica's). If there's a tie, I'll reach out individually and set up next steps.

We realize the ethical dilemma in entrusting this year's competition to the honor system, but we are confident that our values will prevail over a free basketball.

DEADLINE TO SUBMIT RESULTS IS END OF DAY, FEBRUARY 6TH

Ages 9, 10, 11 (Boys & Girls Competitions) Use a women's regulation-size basketball and shoot from a 12-foot foul line (NOTE: The normal foul line is 15 feet from the basket).

Ages 12, 13, 14 (Girls Competitions) Use a women's regulation-size basketball and shoot from the regulation foul line 15 feet

Ages 12, 13, 14 (Boys Competitions) Use a men's regulation-size basketball and shoot from the regulation foul line 15 feet

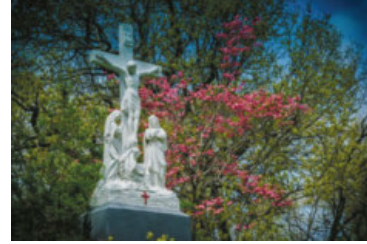
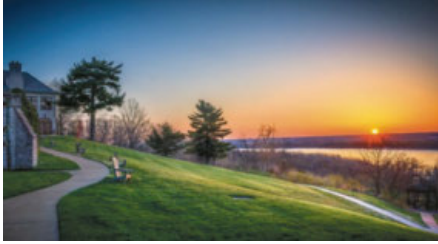

MISSOURI HOUSE COMMITTEE CONSIDERS BILL TO DEFUND PLANNED PARENTHOOD

The Missouri House Special Committee on Government Oversight heard testimony last week on HB 1854, sponsored by Representative Nick Schroer (R-O'Fallon). HB 1854 would prohibit any abortion facility or its affiliates from receiving public funds. Federal and state law currently prohibits public funds from being used for abortion. Schroer's bill would expand that prohibition by denying an abortion provider Medicaid reimbursement for non-abortion health care services.

The Missouri Catholic Conference testified in support of HB 1854. If the bill is voted out of committee, it will go to the full House for debate.
