
MASS SCHEDULE ON MEMORIAL DAY

MISSOURI LEGISLATIVE SESSION WRAP-UP

After the Missouri Senate adjourned a day early, the Missouri House took up numerous bills on the last day of the legislative session, including SB 683, which included language creating a prison nursery program. The prison nursery program, introduced by Rep. Bruce DeGroot as HB 1897, allows the state to set up nurseries in women's prisons so that the children of pregnant inmates can stay with their mothers after they are delivered. These programs have shown promise in reducing inmate recidivism, relieving infant anxiety, and promoting maternal well-being and a better prison environment. The bill has been delivered to the governor. The Missouri Senate did not act on several other bills the Missouri Catholic Conference was tracking, including: an omnibus pro-life bill that would respect fetal remains resulting from abortion and defund Planned Parenthood, among other provisions; a bill ensuring religious groups have access to campus facilities and means of communication; a bill extending Medicaid coverage to post-partum women up to one year after delivery; and a bill extending the sunset date on a program that helps cover medications for those in need. These bills will have to start the process again next year.

BISHOP CHAIRMEN RESPOND TO U.S. SENATE VOTE ON ABORTION ON DEMAND BILL

Earlier this month, the U.S. Senate once again failed to advance a bill that would have imposed abortion on demand nationwide at any stage of pregnancy through federal statute. The Women's Health Protection Act would have eliminated pro-life laws in every state, forced citizens to support abortion with their tax dollars, and likely would have eliminated conscience protections for individual healthcare providers. The Senate failed to advance the bill with a 49-51 vote, in which Democrat Joe Manchin joined all Senate Republicans in opposition. In response to the latest vote, Archbishop William E. Lori of Baltimore, chairman of the USCCB Committee on Pro-Life Activities, and Cardinal Timothy M. Dolan, chairman of the Committee for Religious Liberty, issued a statement expressing their relief that the Senate vote to advance the bill failed for the second time in three months. The chairmen further stated, "As a nation built on the recognition that every human being is endowed by its Creator with the unalienable rights to life, liberty, and the pursuit of happiness, we implore Congress to stop pushing abortion as a solution to the needs of women and young girls, and instead embrace public policy that fully respects and facilitates these rights and the needs of both mother and child."


