


#### SYNOD 2021-2023

Sacred Heart-Saint Benedict Parishes will start the process for facilitating Synodal consultation within the parishes. The Meeting is scheduled for January 30 through May 31, 2022. During this time we will have consultation sessions in parishes across the diocese and we will submit the synthesis of our discussions to the diocesan coordinator by June 1st. 


