Council of Catholic Women

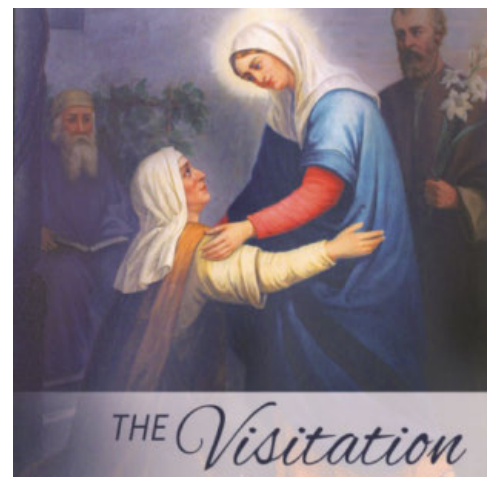
