THE FIRST COMMANDMENT

You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, with all your soul, with all your mind, and with all your strength. (Mk. 12: 29)

Dear brothers and sisters,

The First Commandment of the Law of God shows up in this Sunday's Gospel. It is the first because it is the foundation of our religion. God is love (1 John 4: 8). Religion without love is a religion without God. That is absurd and senseless, as meaningless as a sea without water, an empty sea. If we want to be connected to God, we need to truly love.

But, it cannot be any kind of love. It has to be a fervent and passionate love, a jealous love. Not a sick jealousy, which is the obsessive fear of having a rival man or woman who threatens to win over the love and affection of your dearest person; who threatens to replace you for somebody else. When those thoughts or feelings come from a blind mind or heart, that jealousy is utterly wrong. It is a vice, a dreadful defect, a terrible mental and spiritual disease.

Is there any good jealousy? Yes there is, when it sprouts from a sound mind and a good heart that attempts to defend and protect what is most dear to an individual: their beloved persons. In that sense the love of God is jealous, and God demands from us a jealous love too. *You shall not bow down to carved images or any likeness of anything in heaven above or on earth beneath or in the waters under the earth or serve them. For I, Yahweh your God, am a **jealous God** (Exo 20:5).*

When the apostles saw Jesus casting out the merchants of the temple, they didn't see a hysterical or frantic man, but a man full of love, eager to defend the sanctity of God's house. They recalled the words of the Holy Scripture and considered them very fitting to Jesus' behavior: *I am eaten up with **zeal** for your house* (Joh 2:17; Ps. 69:9). God wants our *jealousy* only for Himself, as we read in the wonderful book of the Imitation of Christ. But He demands nothing he hasn't done first. For he has given up himself completely for us on the Cross, and expects, we yearn for Him in the same *jealous* way.

From the Imitation of Christ:

BLESSED is he who appreciates what it is to love Jesus and who despises himself for the sake of Jesus. Give up all other love for

*His, since He wishes to be loved alone above all things. Affection for creatures is deceitful and inconstant, but the love of Jesus is true and enduring. He who clings to a creature will fall with its frailty, but he who gives himself to Jesus will ever be strengthened. Love Him, then; keep Him as a friend. He will not leave you as others do, or let you suffer lasting death. Sometime, whether you will or not, you will have to part with everything. Cling, therefore, to Jesus in life and death; trust yourself to the glory of Him who alone can help you when all others fail. Your Beloved is such that He will not accept what belongs to another -- **He wants your heart for Himself alone**, to be enthroned therein as King in His own right. If you but knew how to free yourself entirely from all creatures, Jesus would gladly dwell within you. You will find, apart from Him, that nearly all the trust you place in men is a total loss. Therefore, neither confide in nor depend upon a wind-shaken reed, for "all flesh is grass" (Isa 15:6) and all its glory, like the flower of grass, will fade away. You will quickly be deceived if you look only to the outward appearance of men, and you will often be disappointed if you seek comfort and gain in them. If, however, you seek Jesus in all things, you will surely find Him. Likewise, if you seek yourself, you will find yourself -- to your own ruin. For the man who does not seek Jesus does himself much greater harm than the whole world and all his enemies could ever do.*
