

May the peace and joy of Bethlehem's stable fill your hearts with humility and gratitude for our Lord's birth, Emmanuel, God among us!

I sincerely hope you had a wonderful Christmas Eve and keep enjoying it during all these days. Such a big and solemn feast, like Christmas or Easter, have a liturgical OCTAVE. It means for eight days after the feast day is officially declared, it is considered as the very same feast day. Twenty-four hours, one day, is too little, too short of a time to contain the immense happiness and greatness that such a feast needs to be celebrated by all Christians. We need at least eight days!

This year within the joy of this Christmas' Octave, we celebrate today the Feast of the Holy Family, the Family of Nazareth, Jesus, Joseph and Mary—a model love and service for all Christian families.

Let us not forget that we as baptized Christians are sons and daughters of God, our Father. It means we are children of God—we are the Family of the Sons and Daughters of God. That is the Church. And just like the Holy Family's destiny was to reach heaven altogether, our destiny too is the same one. How was the Holy Family to reach heaven? Loving each other, taking care of each other, focusing not on themselves, but on others in order to please and serve their neighbor. By doing that they learned to be glad on earth and eternally in heaven. Because God grants the everlasting happiness of heaven only to those who learned to be glad here on earth, sharing with their neighbors, as St. José María Esrcivá de Balaguer used to say.

May the Holy Family teach us the joy of being together serving each other as Psalm 133 says: *How good, how delightful it is to live as brothers all together! It is like a fine oil on the head, running down the beard, running down Aaron's beard, onto the collar of his robes.*
