

## **Adult Education Notes**

- Today is Holy Family Sunday when we not only celebrate Jesus's Holy Family with Mary and Joseph but also your family, all families, and the institution of family itself, which was deliberately designed by God.
- The first "true" family is God, the Father, the Son, the Holy Spirit. The first designed family was in the Garden of Eden which prefigures our own families. The Church is an extended family. Honor and authority, piety and respect are the glue that holds a family together, and therefore a whole society together. As the family goes so goes the world.
- We were all children once, even Jesus. Honor is the most basic attitude children need to have toward their parents and those who act on their behalf (teachers, bosses, clergy, etc.). Honor and authority relate to one another because honor is respect for authority, and authority is what deserves honor.
- Parenting is the most demanding job in the world. It's the most joyful and the most heart-breaking. The more you invest your love in another person when that love is returned you receive life's greatest deepest joys and greatest deepest sorrows. None of us are perfect and we do the best we can knowing God is in the midst to celebrate those joys and help us through the sorrows.
