
Praise the Lord!

Investment...

Today, without doubt, we can say that the youth (even adults/parents) are surrounded and influenced by social media especially visual media, contemporary culture, unfaithful relationships, foul language, questionable (moral) values etc. The peer pressure is on the other side. They need help; our youth ministry is there to help and support them. But that is not enough and we should not be satisfied by that. Parents have a key role. As St. John Paul II says, *"Those in society ... must never forget that the parents have been appointed by God himself as the first and principal educators of their children and that their right is completely inalienable".*

Parents, be serious about the youth formation. I was surprised to see just two parents for the community meeting last Sunday announced by the new youth Director. How much time, energy and money are invested in sports and games for your children. I know that is needed. But how much more, then, of these to be invested for their spiritual formation which lays a lasting impression for their entire life. Youth ministry can only help and support; can give them a push. But the most important part is to be done by their parents; that is what St. John Paul II reminded the parents years ago. So, I earnestly urge all the parents to take more interest in our youth ministry. Invest your time, energy and resources for their spiritual formation; also, by your example and encouragement and your persistent prayers. And I am sure you will never have to regret it.
