More About Investment...

This is a continuation of last bulletin notes. Just to share with you how you can effectively invest your time for the Christian formation of your children.

St. Paul instructs all Christian parents: "And fathers, do not provoke your children to anger, but bring them up in the discipline and instruction of the Lord." Ephesians 6, 4 (RSV).

This is how children are to be raised – Christian discipline and instruction. I would like to suggest a few things that will help the Christian formation.

- *Pray together:* this is very important, we know. Please find at least 10 to 15 minutes everyday to have a family prayer. If not a rosary, pray at least two decades of the rosary and a small portion from the Bible. Find the saint of the day and share something about him/her.
- *Eat together (at least one meal):* Pope Francis mentioned about it a couple of times and suggested turning off the TV and other media during the time of the meal.
- *Bible study/discussion on Sundays & holy days.* Spent some time reading and discussing the upcoming Sunday's readings. That will indirectly help to prepare for the Sunday Mass and will also help to understand the Word of God.
- *Watch Saints/Christian movies*. Surely it will have some impact on us, their lives of witness will motivate us.
- *Make pilgrimages to holy places:* it can be domestic or international. After watching the movie and making a pilgrimage, discuss and share ideas and experiences.
- Hold in high esteem our faith and Catholic Church. St. Paul says: "Without any doubt, the mystery of our religion is great" 1 Timothy 4, 16 (RSV). Discuss about the Church's performance and thank God for all the good that she is doing and pray to overcome the failures.
- A loving correction of the wrongs done is surely a part of Christian discipline; also encouraging the good qualities and acts.

To sum up there should be a Christian environment in our families to foster our Faith or in other words everything should be focused on increasing our Faith.

Let us earnestly work together for the welfare of our families, especially of our youth and children.
