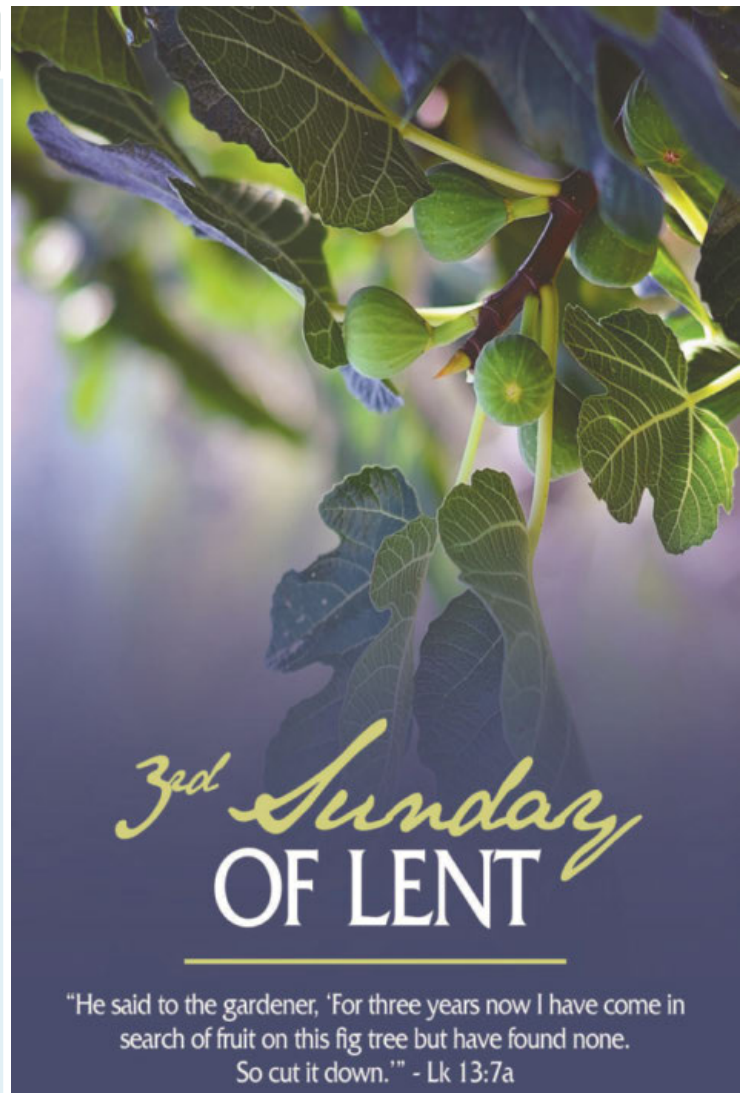

## GOSPEL MEDITATION

### ENCOURAGE DEEPER UNDERSTANDING OF SCRIPTURE

Deserts can be lonely, isolated, and treacherous places. When a person wanders in a desert, they can easily get disoriented, dehydrated, confused, lost, and vulnerable. Temptation is at its peak, especially when confronted with something that may offer some respite or relief, even a mirage. Deserts can bring us to our weakest moment and tempt our faith. The Christian journey can be described as a desert experience as we vacillate back and forth, falling victim to the mirages of our lives versus the true, life-giving water offered by God. We need a burning bush experience in our lives that convinces us of the power of God and reveals Him as the "I am" of all existence.

Moses was leading his flock across the desert when he found himself at Mount Horeb. Mountains give us a fuller perspective of life, a panoramic view of what would otherwise be hidden from the limitations of our sight. That's when Moses met God. We have to find our way to a mountain experience where our vantage point can take on a wider view of life.



Many things can do this for us: the birth of a child, the death of someone we love, the joy that comes from marveling at the beauty of God's work, the pondering of life's mysteries, and the ache of longing found deep within our souls. There are many things in life that can wake us up, give us a clearer, better view of things and become occasions where a bush may burn and God's presence as the eternal uncreated One is revealed.

God is very patient and gives us the time and space we need to figure things out and bear some

good fruit. He doesn't rush to cut us down or get frustrated with our barrenness. But we have to remember that the desert journeys of our lives come with some risks. The major risk is that we will mistakenly believe that the mirages are real. Thus, we fall victim to thinking that the respite and refreshment we seek is discovered in a place other than where it actually is. Our faith and the life of the Church are the safeguards we need to keep us properly orientated so that we don't get lost or confused and stay on course.

*And he told them this parable: "There once was a person who had a fig tree planted in his orchard, and when he came in search of fruit on it but found none, he said to the gardener, 'For three years now I have come in search of fruit on this fig tree but have found none. So cut it down. Why should it exhaust the soil?'" - Lk 13:6-7*

**CUARESMA 2022**

**Regulaciones de Cuaresma:** Miercoles de Ceniza y Viernes Santo es un día de ayuno y abstinencia. Ayunar significa que las dos comidas pequeñas del día no son iguales a la cantidad de una comida más grande. La abstinencia es nuestra abstinencia de comer carne. Ambas prácticas nos dan la oportunidad de ser solidarios con los cristianos de todo el mundo y nos recuerdan el sufrimiento de Cristo. Todas las personas de 14 años o más deben abstenerse de comer carne el Miércoles de Ceniza, todos los viernes de Cuaresma y en Viernes Santo. Todas las personas mayores de 18 años y menores de 59 años deben ayunar el Miércoles de Ceniza y el Viernes Santo. Tambien se nos anima a todos a ofrecer a Dios otros actos de penitencia durante la Cuaresma. No por el "sufrimiento", sino por el amor, que es sacrificio.

**Via cruxis:** todos los viernes a las 6:00 p.m. en la capilla durante la Cuaresma con una merienda después en el salon parroquial a las 6:30 p.m.. Para convivir con todos durante esta temporada de Cuaresma.

**Atizando el Fuego de la Cuaresma**

Creo que todos podemos reconocer que hay una cierta fatiga que se apodera de todos nosotros a medida que nos acercamos al final de la temporada de Cuaresma. La próxima semana es el domingo de Laetare, y encuentro que tan pronto como esas vestimentas rosas comienzan a salir del almacén, nuestra motivación colectiva comienza a desvanecerse.

Lo entiendo. Quizás estés fatigado, yo también. Tal vez estés haciendo bien en tus resoluciones y devociones, pero corres el peligro de ir en punto muerto. O tal vez, como muchos de nosotros este año o en años pasados, no sientes que realmente has comenzado tu viaje de Cuaresma.

De cualquier manera, lo más probable es que el fuego que estaba en tu vientre el Miércoles de Ceniza esté un poco lento. Todos los fuegos eventualmente lo hacen, una vez que consumen lo que los alimenta. Así que aquí haríamos bien en recordar qué alimenta nuestro fuego de Cuaresma.

Cuando Moisés se quita las sandalias para acercarse a la zarza ardiente, ve que el fuego arde intensamente, pero no se consume. Lo impulsa algo inagotable, algo que no es de este mundo.

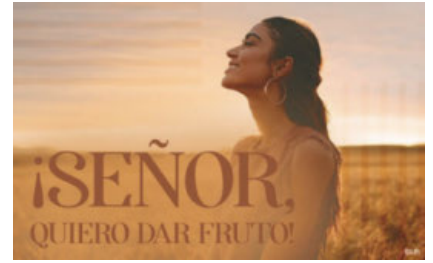

No se puede echar en saco roto la predicación de Jesús, urge la conversión, el Evangelio evoca diversos motivos para el cambio radical de la persona. La gente le pregunta y él responde con claridad y sencillez. San Gregorio Magno (540-604. Homilía 31, 4), exhorta a las personas con una reflexión profunda sobre la higuera que no da fruto: *“Con un grande temor se debe escuchar lo que se dice: Córdala. ¿Para qué ocupa la tierra inútilmente? Cada uno a su manera, si no hace buenas obras. Pero desde el momento que ocupa un espacio en la vida presente, es un árbol que ocupa inútilmente el terreno, porque en ese lugar en donde está, impide que ahí se ponga otro a trabajar”*.

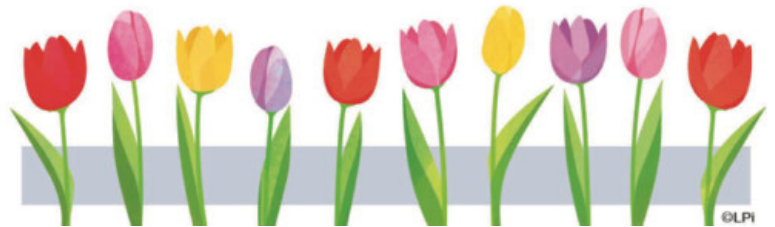


Continua su homilía. *“Pero hay algo más grave, y es que los poderosos de este mundo, si no realizan ningún bien, no lo hacen producir ni siquiera en aquellos que dependen de ellos, porque su ejemplo actúa sobre sus subalternos como una sombra estimulante de perversidad... Sofocados por la sombra no reciben el calor del sol y permanecen fríos, sin el calor de Dios. Pero el pensamiento de este poderoso, cualquiera que sea su nombre, no es más objeto directo de los cuidados de Dios. Dejarnos cuidar por Dios es el mensaje de Cristo.
