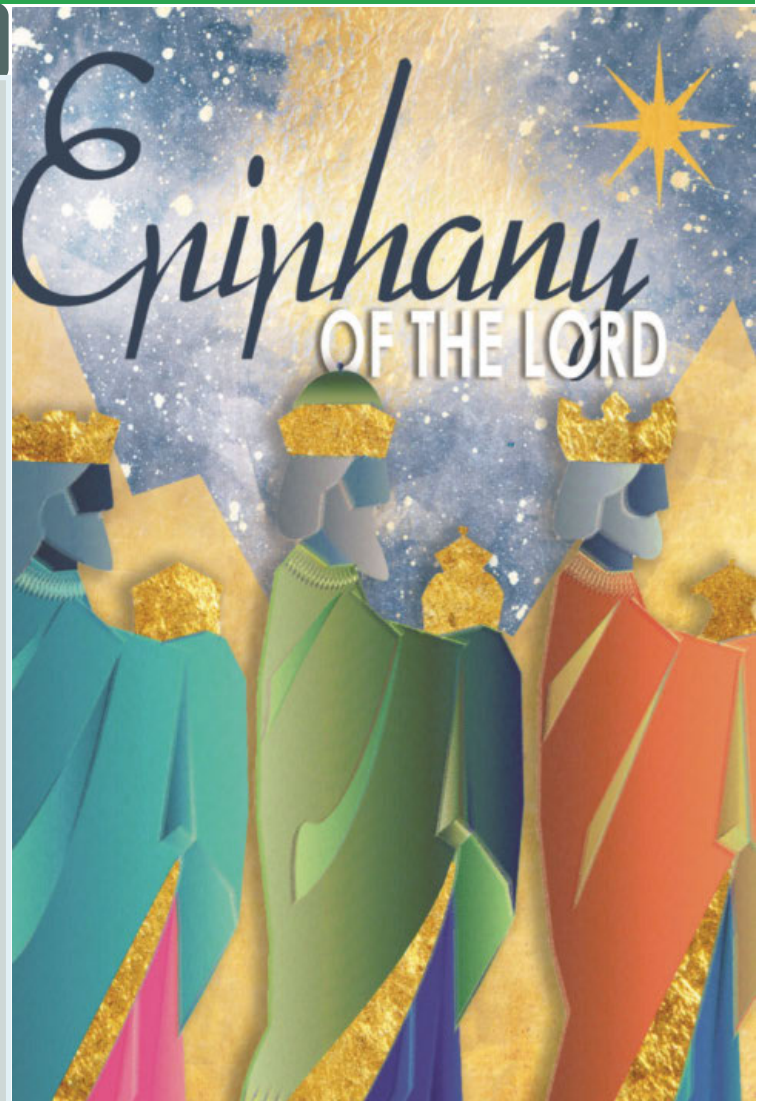

GOSPEL MEDITATION

Encourage Deeper Understanding of Scripture

A friend of mine is a young priest who teaches high school physics at a Catholic boys' prep school. Like many today, the boys often think science and religion are enemies. So, he delights in their raised eyebrows when he reminds them his first full-time job as a priest was to be an astrophysicist. He cataloged the size, shape, and matter of distant stars. He tells them, "Science gave me more love for God, not less."

The Magi were something like scientist-astronomers. Like today's scientists, they employed disciplined methods of discovering dependable patterns in the world. Their rigorous commitment to the truth led them to the joy of discovering Jesus. Their love for knowledge leads them

to worship the Source of all knowledge. Luke says of them, "They were overjoyed at seeing the star."

We may see the universe as cold and empty and feel sad. But why should we do that? The Magi, like my priest-friend, show us there is another way to experience the world. We use our intelligence to discover the beautiful patterns in the world — in mathematics, physics, astronomy, biology, neuroscience, and so on — and allow this to lead us to greater love for God. So, my fellow Magi: the world needs us to be overjoyed at finding God in science and, finally and fully, in Jesus.

LA CORRESPONSABILIDAD DIARIA

El cuento de los Reyes Magos cuando le llevan los regalos a Jesús, el Rey recién nacido, es uno fantástico, ¿no? Tenían una estrella brillante en el cielo que les mostró el camino. No soy Boy Scout, así que no estoy seguro si yo podría seguir una estrella. Pero el punto importante es que Dios los llevó al pesebre. Usted no hubiera creído usted que el pesebre fue el lugar en que el niño Cristo iba nacer si Dios no le hubiera mostrado el camino. Probablemente usted hubiera pasado el pesebre.

En nuestras vidas, no hay estrellas brillantes en el cielo que nos guían. No es fácil determinar a dónde nos lleva Dios. Es posible que queramos usar nuestros dones sabiamente, pero en qué manera y con qué fin no siempre es obvio.

Aquí la oración hace una gran diferencia. Si queremos cultivar una vida contemplativa en que somos conscientes de la presencia de Dios a lo largo del día, es más fácil contestar determinar el llamado. Podemos promover el proceso si cada mañana ofrecemos intencionalmente nuestros días enteros: todas nuestras acciones, todo nuestro tiempo, y todas nuestras decisiones. Por la tarde, podemos examinar las horas pasadas del día y reflexionar en nuestros éxitos y fracasos en contestar al llamado de Cristo. Después resolvemos a empezar otra vez mañana, invitando a Cristo a estar con nosotros por cada paso. Dios no nos va a ofrecer una estrella como guía en el cielo, pero si lo invitamos a nuestro viaje cada día, el camino será más claro.



MEDITACIÓN DEL EVANGÉLIO

8 de enero de 2023
Día de la Epifanía del Señor

Existe un refrán popular que dice así: “*No hay peor sordo que el que no quiere oír*”. Y le agregaría el que no quiere ver. Los Magos del Oriente no se hicieron sordos ni ciegos, sino que, presurosos siguieron la estrella que los guiaba a Jesús. Preguntaron y escucharon su historia, por aquello de no perderse del lugar donde se encontraba aquel famoso recién nacido. “¿Dónde está el rey de los judíos que acaba de nacer? (Mateo 2,2). ¿Dónde está Jesús en nuestros días? ¿A quién hemos preguntado donde encontrarlo? Quizá, se encuentra en los corazones de los padres de familia que han perdido a sus hijos(as) en la violencia, o tal vez está ahí donde el inmigrante sufre y muere luchando por una vida mejor.

La liturgia de este Domingo de la Epifanía, manifestación de Jesús como salvador de todos los pueblos, nos invita a no ser oyentes pasivos sino activos, comprometidos a la esperanza de una sociedad mejor. La voz del Papa Francisco es el eco de Dios que motiva a ver la luz de la estrella reflejada en el corazón de todo aquel que desea la paz.

“El día de hoy debemos sentir cerca a los Magos, ellos tenían el corazón abierto al horizonte: «Vieron la estrella porque se habían puesto en el camino» (San Juan Crisóstomo). Ellos reflejan la imagen de todos los que no dejamos de levantar la mirada hacia el firmamento, poniendo en nuestro camino a nuestro Dios, Rey del Universo”.
