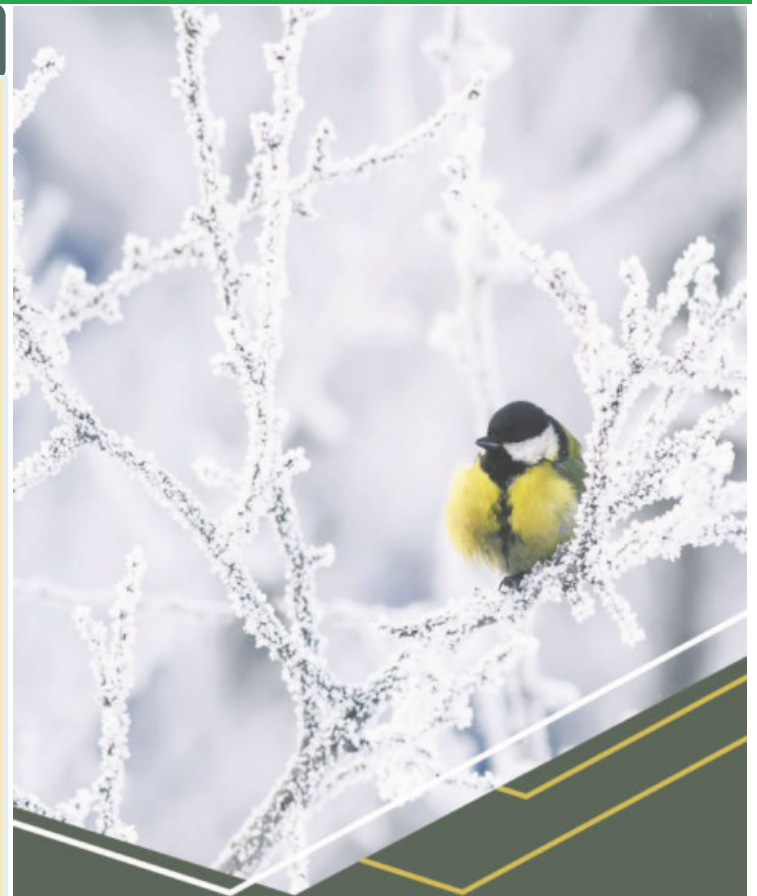

2º DOMINGO DEL TIEMPO ORDINARIO

“Pues bien, yo lo vi y doy testimonio de que éste es el Hijo de Dios”. - Jn 1, 34

LA CORRESPONSABILIDAD DIARIA

Se puede imaginar la respuesta de mis niños si los pregunto: “¿Quién quiere limpiar la concina después de cenar hoy?” ¡Seis ojos me mirarían como si tuviera dos cabezas! Si les pido en términos de voluntariado, he sugerido que ellos no tienen ninguna propiedad en la situación. Es posible que a veces piensen que mi esposa y yo son sus sirvientes para cuidarles, pero le aseguro que no he recibido ninguna compensación para mis servicios.

Cuando donamos sangre, sacrificamos nuestro tiempo y nuestra sangre a la Cruz Roja. La Cruz Roja no nos emplea, y no somos dueños de ninguna parte de la Cruz Roja. Simplemente nos sacrificamos para una causa noble.

Como parroquianos somos parte de una familia parroquial. Somos de una comunidad parroquial. No *visitamos* la iglesia cada domingo porque no podemos visitar a nuestro hogar. El llamado del cuerpo de Cristo ocurre en cada parroquia y nuestra respuesta debe ser como el del salmista: “Aquí estoy, Señor, para hacer tu voluntad”. La corresponsabilidad verdadera nunca enumera el precio y nunca pide voluntarios. Nos damos porque somos parte de algo más importante que nosotros, y la parte superior de esta comunidad es Jesús. Después de cenar en mi casa, alguien tiene que limpiar la cocina. En su comunidad parroquial, también alguien tiene que contestar al llamado de Cristo. En los dos casos, no se deben voluntarios; sino confiamos en la familia.

MEDITACIÓN DEL EVANGÉLIO

15 de enero de 2023

2º Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario

Con la Fiesta del Bautismo del Señor terminamos el Tiempo de la Navidad. Hoy iniciamos lo que se llama el Tiempo Ordinario. El Catecismo de la Iglesia Católica nos explica lo que este tiempo significa: *“El año litúrgico es el desarrollo de los diversos aspectos del único misterio pascual. Esto vale muy particularmente para el ciclo de las fiestas en torno al Misterio de la Encarnación (Anunciación, Navidad, Epifanía) que conmemoran el comienzo de nuestra salvación y nos comunican las primicias del misterio de Pascua”*. El Tiempo Ordinario es el más largo del año, consta de 33 a 34 semanas, se celebra en una primera etapa antes de la Cuaresma, y otra, más larga, después del Tiempo Pascual. Los colores litúrgicos también tienen un papel muy importante en las celebraciones litúrgicas y este tiempo la Iglesia se engalana con el color verde.

Además del entorno que nos rodea dentro de la iglesia, lo más importante de cada domingo es escuchar la Palabra de Dios y descubrir el mensaje de Jesús y ponerlo en práctica en la vida diaria. En el Evangelio, Juan indica el punto a seguir: *“Detrás de mí viene un hombre que ya está delante de mí, porque era antes que yo... Sí, yo lo he visto, y declaro que éste es el Elegido de Dios”* (Juan 1,29.34). Juan es el elegido de Dios, testigo de la divinidad, el que nos muestra al Cordero de Dios que quita el pecado del mundo. No es fácil dejar paso a otro que nos quita el lugar y más si tenemos fama y amigos que nos reconocen. Juan ve a Jesús, comprende y le deja libre el camino.

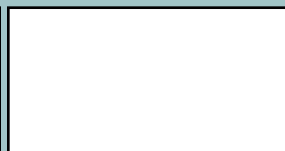

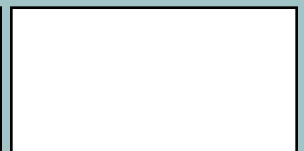
