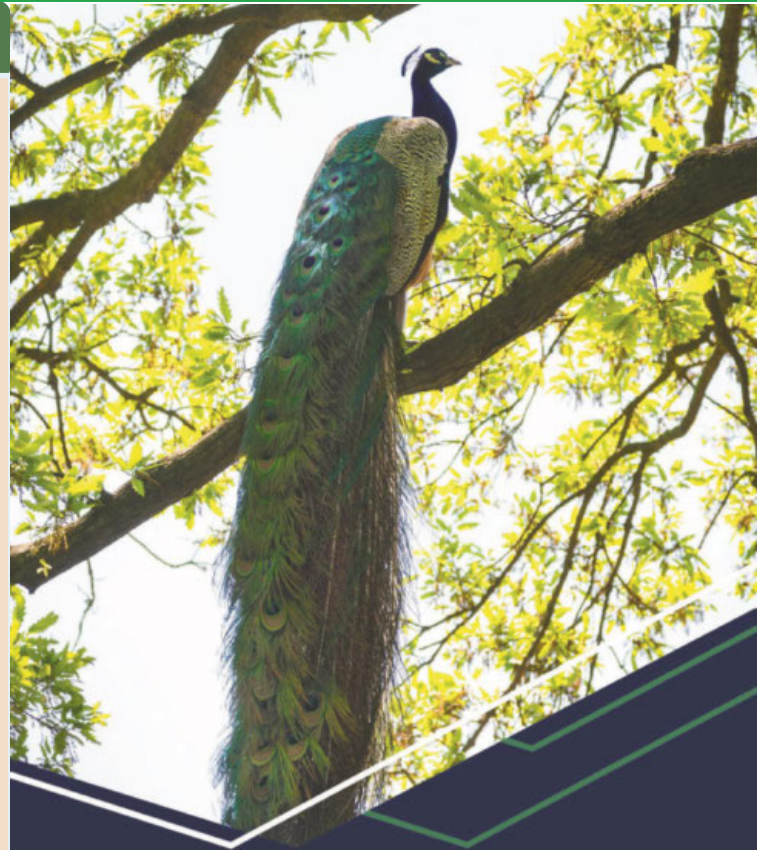

LA CORRESPONSABILIDAD DIARIA

Los humildes de la tierra

Cuando pienso en las Bienaventuranzas, pienso en tazas de café coleccionables adornadas con las palabras *Bienaventurados los pacificadores*, con florecillas de color pastel estampadas en los espacios en blanco de las letras. Pienso en tarjetas de felicitación y tapices decorativos.

¿Por qué? Estas son las Bienaventuranzas, por el amor de Dios, revolucionarias y radicales. Una acusación intransigente de los valores mundanos. Son lo opuesto a lo banal.

Pero me encogí de la cabeza a los pies cuando leí el primer borrador de esta reflexión, un recuento de un momento de mi vida en el que decidí abrazar la humildad y la mansedumbre. Me di cuenta de que las Bienaventuranzas no son algo de lo que pueda hablarte. La pobreza de espíritu, el hambre de justicia, el gozo que Dios da a los oprimidos, son conceptos que deben animarse en nosotros. Deben ser vividos.

Así que, en lugar de contarte mi historia, quiero que cuentes la tuya.

Te invito a pensar en un momento en que fuiste vulnerable. Cuando estabas desanimado o humillado o te sentiste como un fracasado. Un tiempo en el que te cortaron bajo. La pérdida de un empleo, tal vez, o el rechazo de un ser querido. El final abrupto de un camino que estabas seguro sería largo y próspero.

El resentimiento, la envidia y la venganza florecen en momentos como este. ¿Experimentaste esos sentimientos? ¿Los abrazaste? ¿Querías hacerlo?

¿Qué te dijo el mundo que debería significar este momento?

¿Qué te dice Cristo que debería significar? ¿Lo has descubierto o todavía estás trabajando en ello?

Pues Dios ha elegido a los ignorantes de este mundo, para humillar a los sabios; a los débiles del mundo, para avergonzar a los fuertes. — 1 Corintios 1:27 © LPi

MEDITACIÓN DEL EVANGÉLIO

29 de enero de 2023

4° Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario

La sociedad actual tiene una necesidad imperante de buscar la comodidad, la riqueza, la fama y el poder. Sin embargo, el Evangelio de hoy narra las bienaventuranzas y la primera de ellas invita a la pobreza: *“Felices los que tienen espíritu del pobre, porque de ellos es el Reino de los cielos”* (Mateo 5,3). Al contrario de esta bienaventuranza, los anuncios en los medios de comunicación son de comodidad y riqueza. Estos no se llevan con la pobreza de espíritu, mucho menos con la Buena Nueva del Evangelio, donde Dios anuncia la salvación a los pobres y va con los pobres.

El sermón del monte declara solemnemente el anuncio de la Buena Nueva a los pobres y necesitados. Esto no quiere decir que se esté contra los ricos, por el contrario, compartir los bienes recibidos dan más abundancia. La solidaridad y misericordia de unos para con los otros es camino seguro para convertir un corazón duro y cerrado, en un corazón compasivo y dadivoso. Ser pobre de espíritu quiere decir confiar y abandonarse en Dios, aunque se tengan bienes materiales. La persona sencilla se somete a Dios confiando en su voluntad. Si analizamos a los santos y santas de Dios, ellos se caracterizan por ser pobres, justos y sencillos. *¿Cuál de las bienaventuranzas te ayuda a cambiar el corazón y te lleva a la conversión? ¿Conoces a alguien que sea pobre de espíritu y limpio de corazón? ¿Qué imitarías de esa persona?* Ser felices, ser pobres, significa ser constructores de la paz, dejar la violencia y el egoísmo. *¿Podremos?*

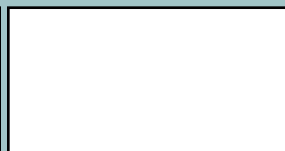

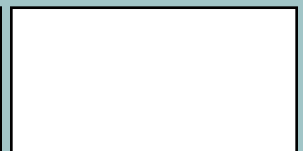
