Your Envelope Counts— Utility expenses are 5% of the total budgeted expense of the parish. These expenses include electricity, gas, water, sewer, telephone, television, and cable/internet services. For fiscal 2020, total utility expenses of \$47,113 were \$3,787 below the budget and \$3,995 below the cost for the prior fiscal year. This is primarily due to the school, parish center, and church being closed for two months due to COVID-19.

Su Sobre Cuenta— Los gastos de servicios públicos son el 5% del gasto total presupuestado de la parroquia. Estos gastos incluyen electricidad, gas, agua, alcantarillado, teléfono, televisión y servicios de cable / internet. Para el año fiscal 2020, los gastos totales de servicios públicos de \$47,113 fueron \$3,787 por debajo del presupuesto y \$3,995 por debajo del costo del año fiscal anterior. Esto se debe principalmente a que la escuela, el centro parroquial y la iglesia están cerrados por dos meses debido a COVID-19.
