Your Envelope Counts— The cost of maintaining the properties is a growing expenditure for the parish. The cost includes the monthly charge from the Archdiocese for property and liability insurance, custodial and cleaning supplies, maintenance costs for the buildings and equipment, inspection of all alarms and equipment, cleaning of carpets, maintenance of grounds and landscaping, including the Brownstown property, and maintenance contracts on the elevator, church bells, and organ. The budgeted monthly cost in fiscal 2021 for these items is \$8,698.

Su Sobre Cuenta— El costo de mantener las propiedades es un gasto creciente para la parroquia.
