Your Envelope Counts— The Office of Accounting Services at the Archdiocese invoices each parish monthly for costs incurred on behalf of the parish. The invoice balance is withdrawn from the parish checking account on the last business day of the month. The St. Ambrose monthly billing includes the wages and stipends of Fr. Dan; health insurance costs for clergy, retired religious, and lay employees; retirement and worker compensation costs of lay employees; property insurance and assessments; Criterion subscriptions: the cathedraticum; and the cost of continuing education courses. The cost of these items each month is \$30,153. In addition, each month there may be additional one-time charges from the Archdiocese.



Su Sobre Cuenta— La Oficina de Servicios de Contabilidad de la Arquidiócesis factura mensualmente a cada parroquia por los costos incurridos en nombre de la parroquia. El saldo de la factura se retira de la cuenta corriente de la parroquia el último día hábil del mes. La facturación mensual de San Ambrosio incluye los salarios y estipendios del Padre Dan; costos de seguro médico para clérigos, religiosos jubilados y empleados laicos; costos de jubilación y compensación laboral de empleados laicos; seguros y tasaciones de propiedad; Suscripciones a criterios: el cathedraticum; y el costo de los cursos de educación continua. El costo de estos artículos cada mes es de \$30,153. Además, cada mes puede haber cargos adicionales únicos de la Arquidiócesis.

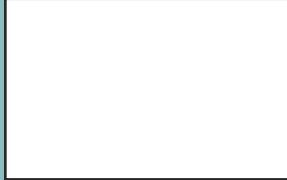
