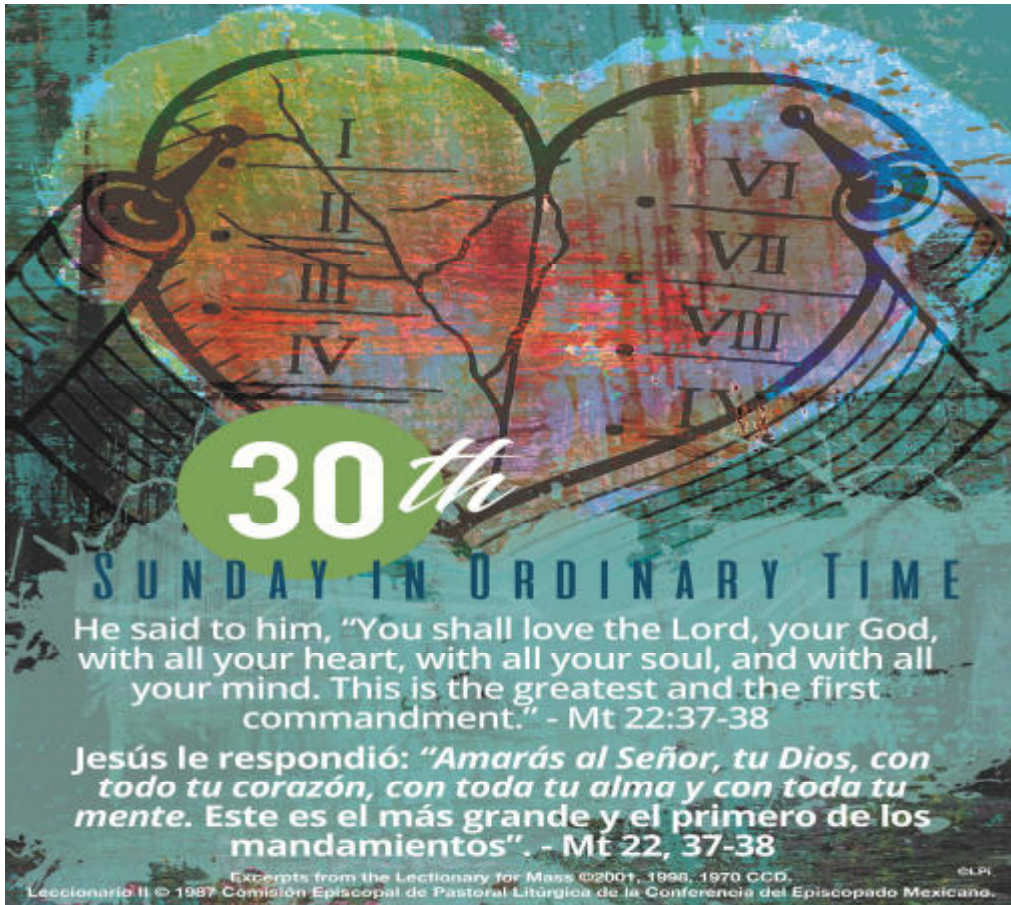

Your generosity helps fund 2 clinics and nurses that provide much needed medical care for the families in and near Gaspard. We have also helped with expenses for the church, teachers, school programs, donkeys, and vehicle repairs. You may donate by using your monthly collection envelopes, by EFT withdrawals, or by sending funds designating them to be used for Haiti. Funds are transferred on a quarterly basis to St. Therese. This past week, we transferred \$4,700.00 to our sister parish to assist with their needs. Your generous support dramatically improves the lives of our brothers and sisters in Haiti. The Haiti committee meets quarterly in the parish center. During the pandemic, we have been meeting virtually. Su generosidad ayuda a financiar 2 clínicas y enfermeras que brindan la atención médica que tanto necesitan las familias de Gaspard y sus alrededores. También hemos ayudado con los gastos de la iglesia, maestros, programas escolares, burros y reparaciones de vehículos. Puede donar usando sus sobres de colección mensual, mediante retiros de EFT o enviando fondos para designarlos para Haití. Los fondos se transfieren trimestralmente a St. Therese. La semana pasada, transferimos \$ 4,700.00 a nuestra parroquia hermana para ayudar con sus necesidades. Su generoso apoyo mejora dramáticamente la vida de nuestros hermanos y hermanas en Haití. El comité de Haití se reúne trimestralmente en el centro parroquial. Durante la pandemia, nos hemos estado reuniendo virtualmente.
