



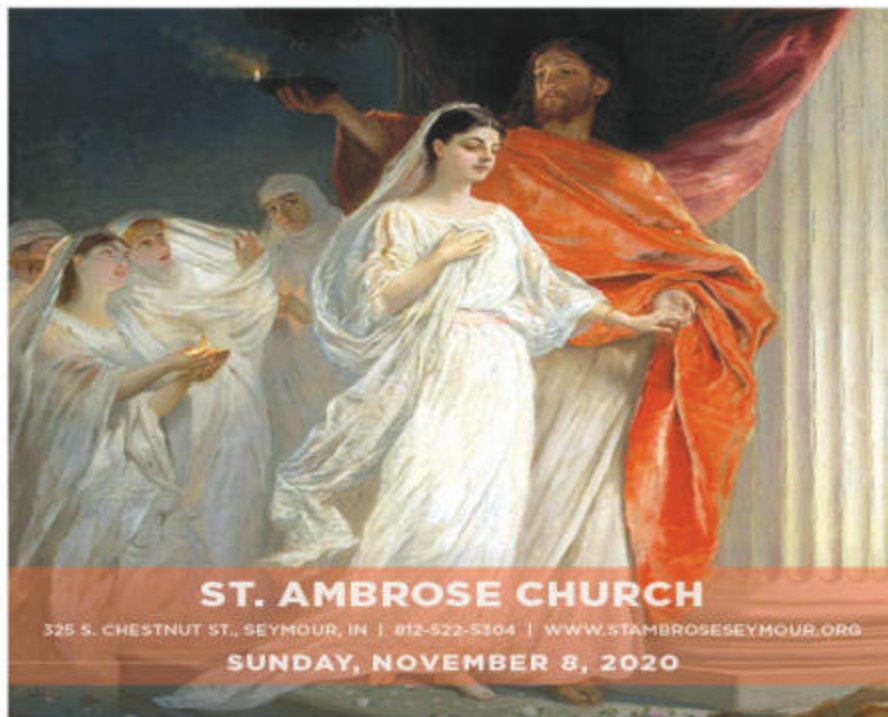

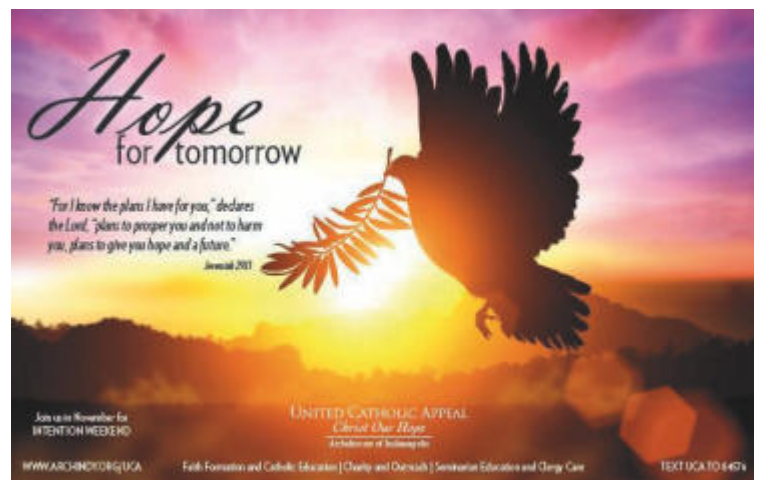

Your Envelope Counts—

November 8, 2020 - The first semester installment of the Choice Scholarship Award (voucher program) for the current school year has been paid by the Indiana Department of Education to schools with qualified students. The payment received by St. Ambrose Catholic School was \$150,113. This payment benefits eighty-four students attending our school. This payment is \$5,793 lower than the first payment a year ago. The program allows qualified students to attend St. Ambrose School without using parish scholarship (Guardian Angel) or other available scholarship funds for financial assistance to meet the family's obligation to the School.

El pago recibido por la Escuela Católica de San Ambrosio fue de \$150,113. Este pago beneficia a ochenta cuatro estudiantes que asisten a nuestra escuela. Este pago es \$5,793 menos que el primer pago hace un año. El programa permite que los estudiantes calificados asistan a la escuela San Ambrosio sin utilizar la beca parroquial (Ángel de la Guardia) u otros fondos de becas disponibles para obtener ayuda financiera para cumplir con la obligación de la familia con la escuela.
