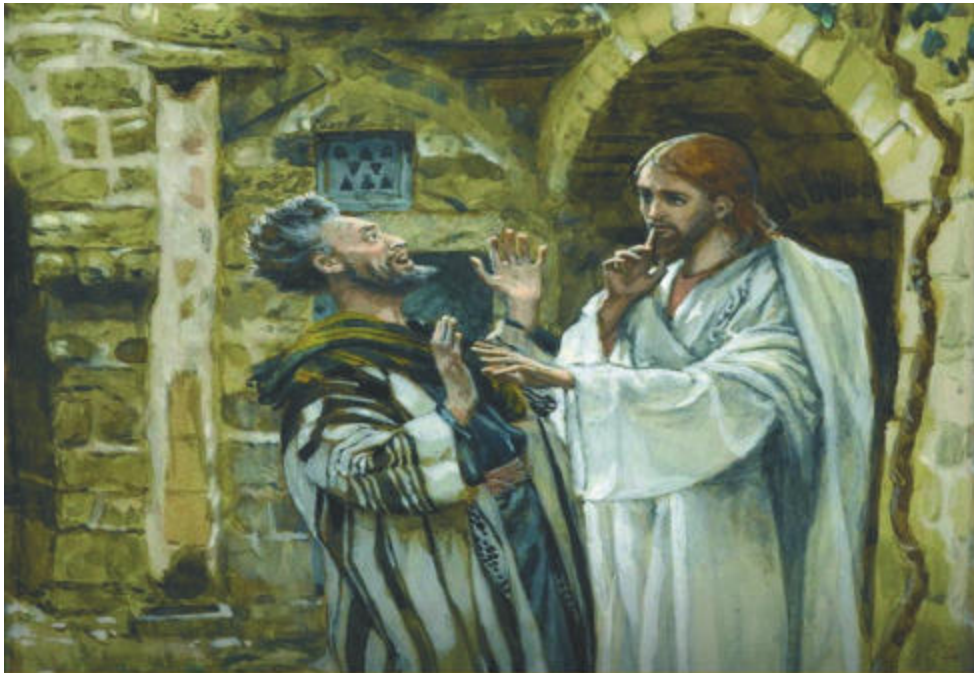
A Note from Fr. Dan ~

So he went into their synagogues, preaching and driving out demons throughout the whole of Galilee.

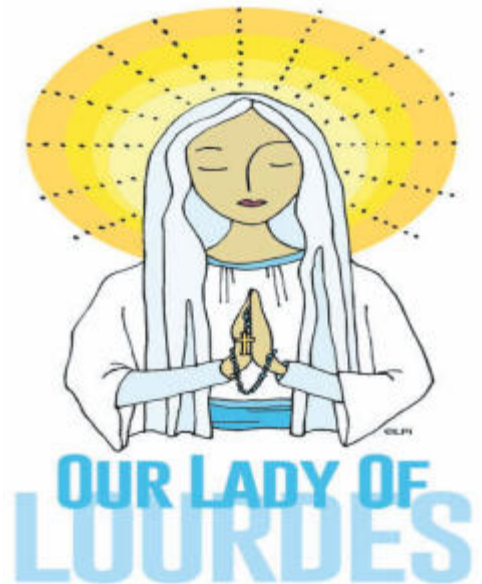
Una Nota del Padre Dan ~
