

- \*For each additional person in the household add \$451

The box of the monthly food supplements may include items such as:

-Canned fruits -Canned vegetables -Cheese -Juice -Cereal -Canned and dry milk

-Peanut butter -Canned meat -Rice, instant potatoes or pasta




