Stockbox is a free program that provides a box of healthy food every month to *seniors 60 years and old- er* to help improve their diet and nutrition,

- \*Monthly income before tax deductions for 1 person in a household is \$1,316
- \*Monthly income before tax deductions for 2 people in a household is \$1,784
- \*For each additional person in the household add \$451

The box of the monthly food supplements may include items such as:

-Cheese -Canned fruits -Canned vegetables -Juice -Cereal -Canned and dry milk

-Peanut butter -Canned meat -Rice, instant potatoes or pasta

Applications and distribution will occur monthly at the center on Wednesdays, of the first full week each month.
