



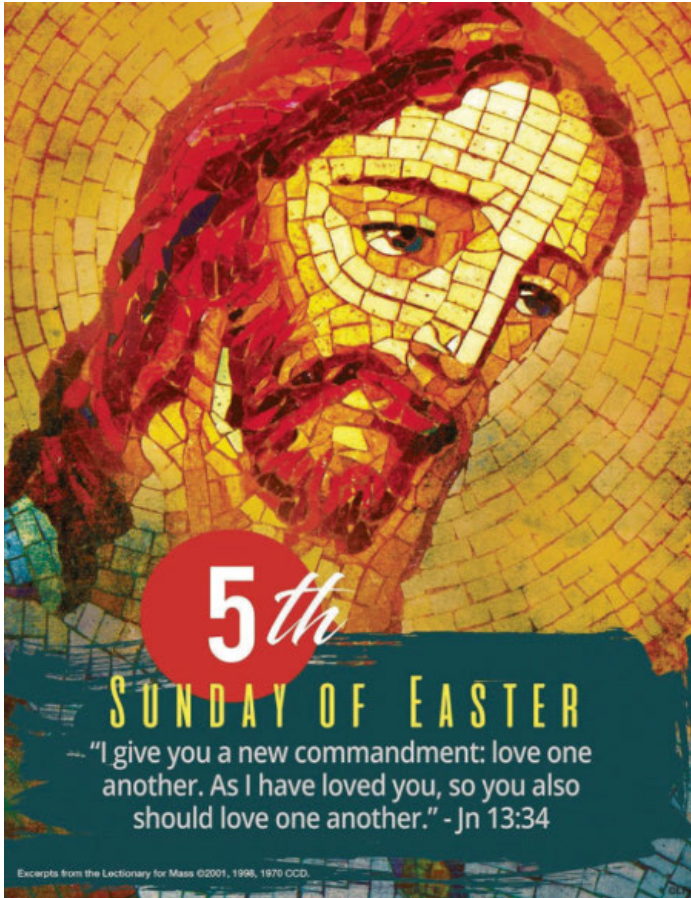

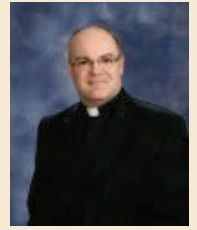
Decorations are allowed year-round if set directly on the headstone or in the cement foundation. Please make sure items are attached **securely**.

St. John, Peosta has a Hearing Loop for hearing aid users.

Hearing Loops allow people with hearing aids or cochlear implants to receive the sound from the PA system directly in their own hearing aids without having to pick up a separate listening device. Check with your audiologist to see if your hearing aid has a T-coil or Telecoil built in. (If you have hearing loss but do not have a hearing aid or if your hearing aid does not have a working telecoil setting to access the hearing loop, there are individual receivers that are available.)

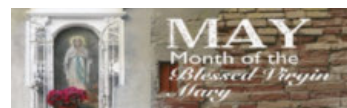

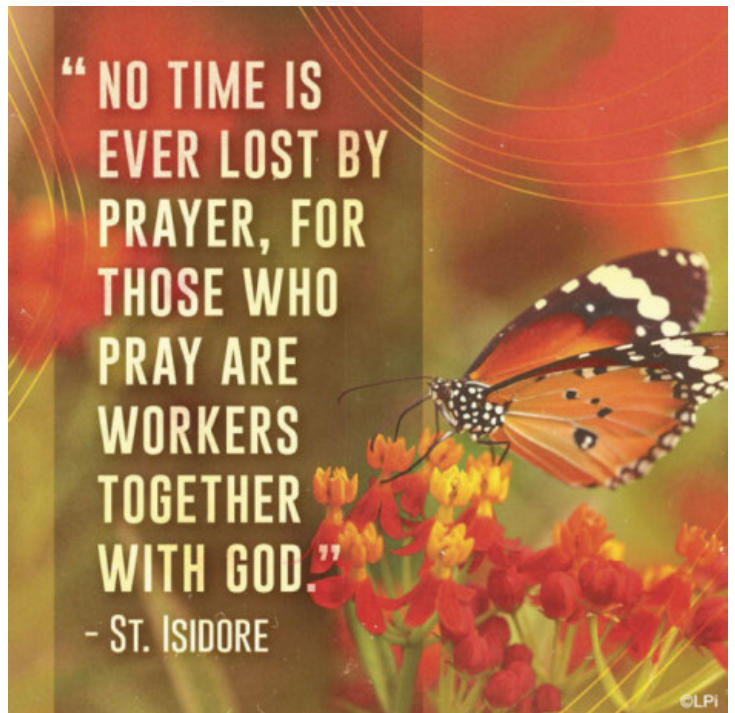
