



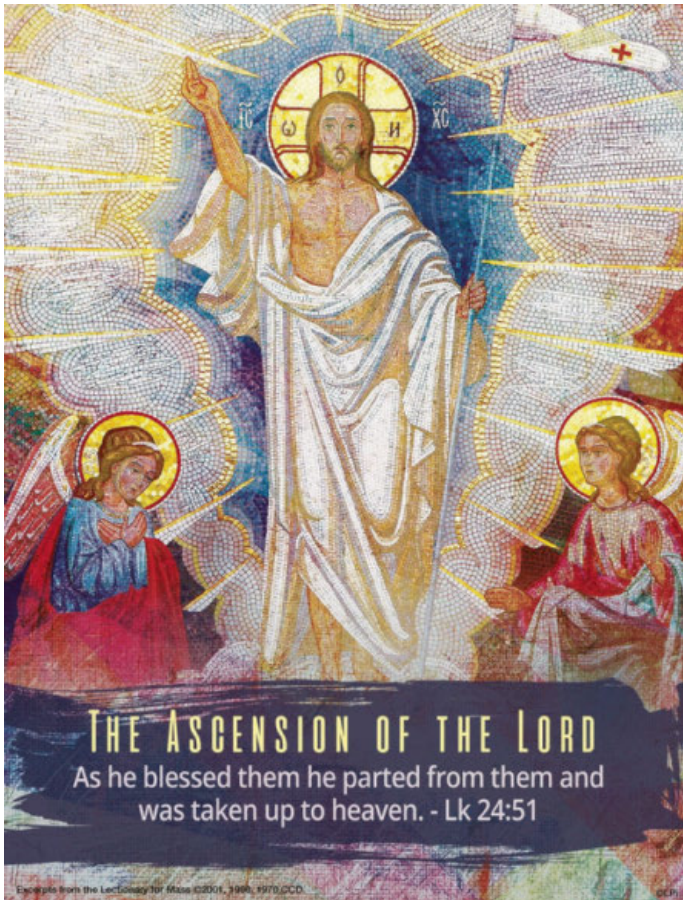

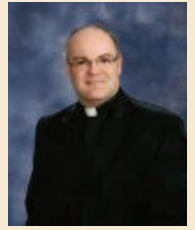

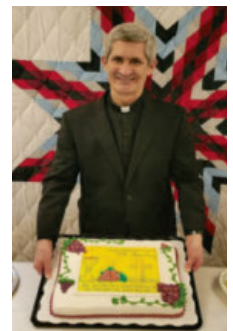
What can I do for my neighbor to show the love that God has for me?

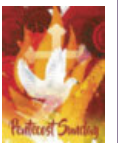
