



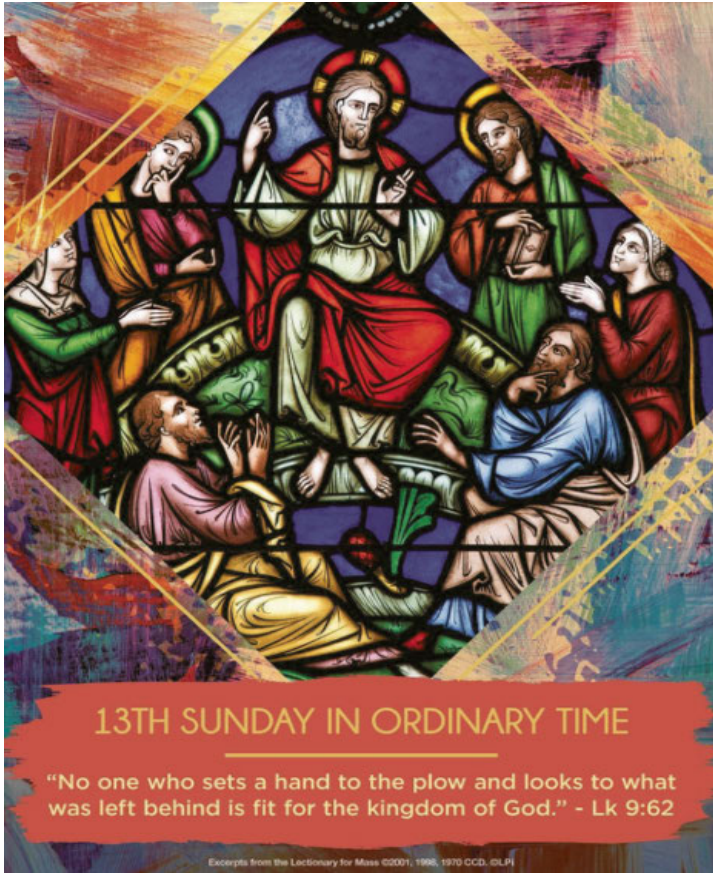

LIVE THE LITURGY

God calls us in the midst of ordinary things. Often only looking for God in the dramatic, spectacular, the ritual or the sacred places, we miss that He is walking beside us. Every moment of every day, in every circumstance and experience, God is calling to us, "Follow me." Sometimes, we are too distracted to hear this call. Other times, we would rather ignore it or pretend it wasn't heard. God, however, is very persistent. Whether we fine tune our hearing to receive this invitation now or when we close our eyes in death, we need to make a choice. The choice involves leaving some things behind and moving forward, taking risks. Choosing to keep focused and single-minded, the lens we then use to see our world and one another is God's, not our own. Life is no longer about what is important or matters to me but what matters to God. We acquire a new filter and are asked to use that filter to make choices, establish priorities, and determine what direction we will take, and how to love. 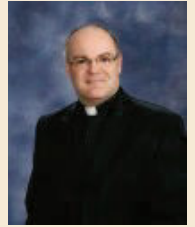

FROM THE PASTOR

After several months of Lent and Easter, and Solemnities, we return to our Ordinary Time readings, and we pick up where we left off before Lent started. Our readings this weekend focus on the call of discipleship. In our first reading, Elisha, the prophet, is called to leave behind his former life and begin anew as a prophet of the Lord. Jesus reminds us in the gospel of the need to be “all in” when the Lord calls.



Other items to note:

- Fr. Kruse is continuing to heal and anticipates returning to his home in Peosta this weekend or early in the week. He will need PT and individual care for a while and has made arrangements. He hopes to be back celebrating mass in the parishes in a couple of weeks.
- An endowment fund has been established at St. John the Evangelist in Placid for the benefit of children who attend Seton Catholic or Beckman Catholic. There will be two \$250 grants for tuition assistance this year. To be eligible, your family must be a registered parishioner at St. John in Placid, state a financial need, and demonstrate a commitment of service to the parish. Please contact me if you are interested in being considered for one of these grants. As the fund grows, more assistance will be available. Everyone is welcome to contribute to the fund.
- The end of our fiscal year is approaching. Thank you for your financial generosity. This has been a challenging year with the steep rise in prices. I appreciate your continued financial support. Our financial books for the fiscal year will close on Thursday this week and reports will be generated in the coming weeks. Additional funds to help us close the fiscal year are greatly appreciated.
- The cemetery committee in Placid is raffling off a new Can Am UTV to raise money for the new road they are installing through the cemetery. Tickets are available at the office in Epworth, \$20 a piece/five tickets for \$100. The drawing will be on September 4.

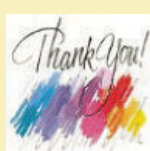
Synod Survey Report Available

The Synod Survey Report has been posted on the archdiocesan website at www.dbqarch.org.

This report was sent to the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops and is the report for the archdiocesan family as well. The report summarizes the significant findings, conclusions and next steps in this work to build parish vibrancy.

Also posted are detailed summaries from each section of the survey (including short answer questions), focus groups and copy of the survey used. This information will provide further details and support for the significant findings and conclusions found in the Synod Survey Report. It will also provide much insight into what the nearly 16,000 participants feel.

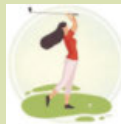
