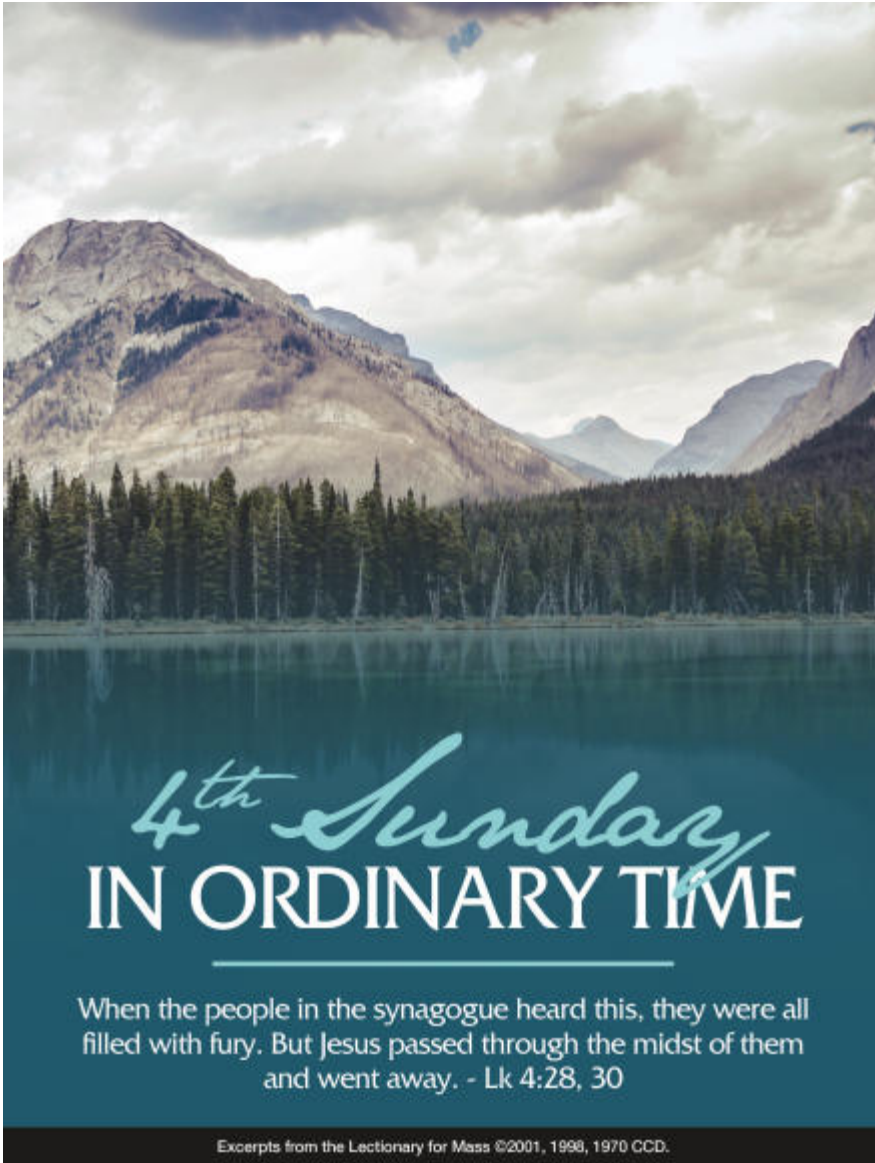

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

As we begin the month of February, we recognize this as Black History Month. Although that is not a part of our Liturgical calendar as such, we can still call attention to it. Our diocesan offices include an office of Black Catholic Ministry whose director is Veronica Wilhite. She recently sent an email calling attention to some of the material for Black History Month that will be available on KET including a show on George Washington Carver, an episode of "Finding Your Roots", and an episode from "Live from Lincoln Center". On our Formed material online, I would like to call your attention to an audiobook about the life of Fr. Augustus Tolton, *From Slave to Priest*. He was a priest of the diocese of Alton Illinois and served at his home parish in Quincy Illinois. He also served as a pastor at St. Monica's in Chicago. He was born a slave in Ralls County Missouri where he was baptized at St. Peter's Catholic Church, and he eventually ended up in Quincy Illinois. He studied for the priesthood in Rome and was ordained there. It is comforting to me to see how the Church at the universal level at the time was able to call him to the priesthood even with the difficulties that he faced at home.

### BULLETIN BITES

**And Jesus said, "Amen, I say to you, no prophet is accepted in his own native place."**

If we become a star athlete or acquire great wealth, our high school or hometown may honor us as "Person of the Year" or dedicate a plaque to us. However, if we challenge people to do great things, there may be no plaque for us. Jesus entered the synagogue in his home town of Nazareth and read a passage from Isaiah that prophesied the coming of the Messiah and then He said it had been fulfilled in their midst. The people of Nazareth knew Jesus well. He grew up and lived among them. He was one of them. He was like them. He had not yet done anything to indicate that He was the Messiah. Nevertheless, the people knew the Messiah would do great things. If Jesus was the Messiah, there was no reason why they, too, could not do great things. If Jesus could not prove to them that He was the Messiah, there would be no pressure on them to be better than they wanted to be. Jesus knew that familiarity breeds doubt. He challenged the people of Nazareth to accept Him despite their doubt - to have faith in Him. Do we sometimes doubt Jesus? Do we accept Him as Messiah despite our doubt? Do we have faith in Him?
