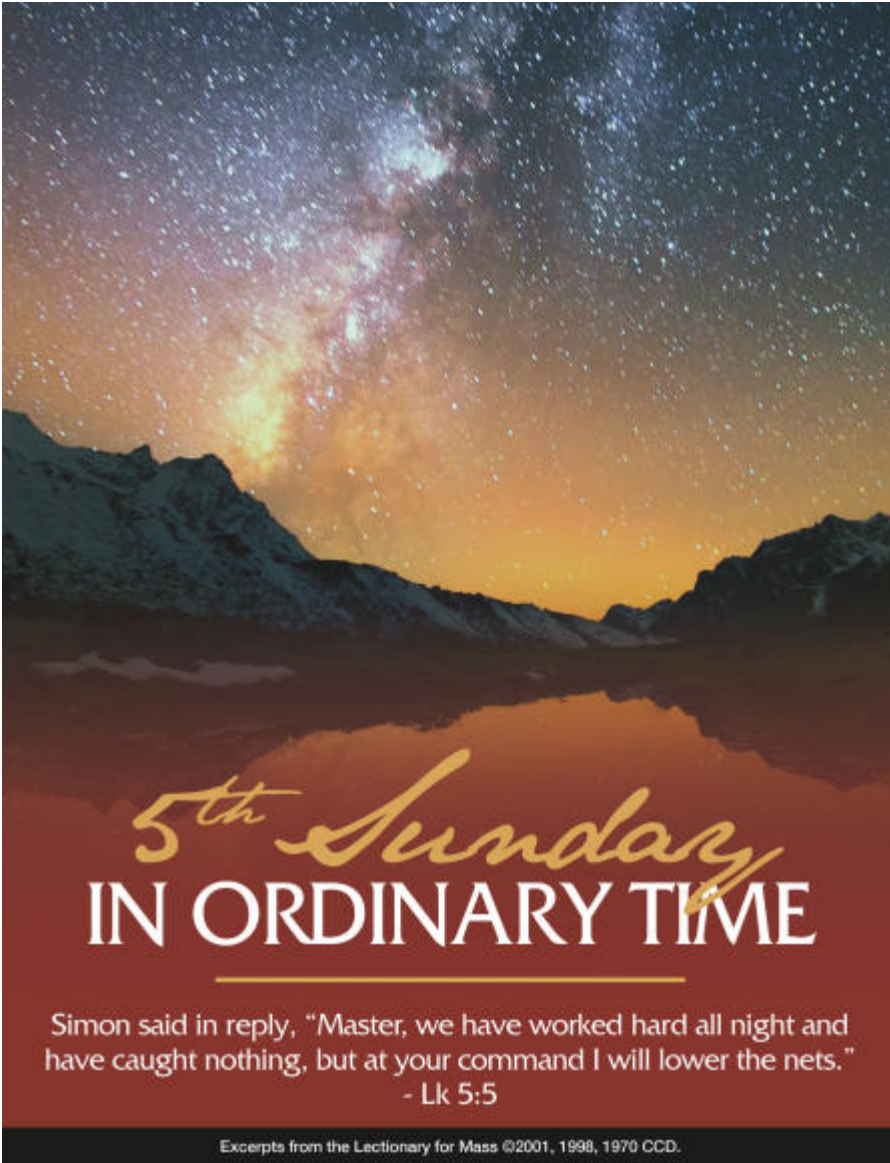

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

The second Sunday of February is set apart as World Marriage Day, and we also have National Marriage Week USA from February 7<sup>th</sup> to the 14<sup>th</sup>. It is important to give attention to marriage in an ongoing way, especially considering the cultural factors of today that challenge the vocation of marriage. The US bishops have set up a website for marriage “foryourmarriage.org” that offers resources for dating and engagement, marriage and parenting. I would invite you to visit the site. One thing that comes to mind for me is the notion of the family as the domestic church. This is found in *Lumen gentium* of the Second Vatican Council quoted below. In it we are reminded of how the partners share in the unity and fruitful love of Christ and His Church, the role of the partners in marriage to foster holiness in one another, and their role in the faith life of their children. That leads us to the importance of time together in meals, prayer and recreation where God is encountered in ordinary moments. It would seem that all three are important to foster in family life. Those activities do not necessarily happen automatically, so even if it may seem awkward, it is important to be deliberate in fostering those activities. I would especially encourage prayer before meals. It is one of the prominent memories that I have of my youth. I would especially encourage husbands to take the initiative to call the family to prayer. A perhaps surprising example of family prayer can be found in a television show called Blue Bloods (referring to a multi-generational Irish Catholic family with a tradition of career police work) that always has scenes around the dinner table and at times includes the prayer. Such an example should not be the exception but the norm. May the families of our parish here be shining examples of the domestic church in which the ordinary day-to-day activities of family life are occasions of joy and holiness.

Finally, Christian spouses, in virtue of the sacrament of Matrimony, whereby they signify and partake of the mystery of that unity and fruitful love which exists between Christ and His Church, help each other to attain to holiness in their married life and in the rearing and education of their children. By reason of their state and rank in life they have their own special gift among the people of God. From the wedlock of Christians there comes the family, in which new citizens of human society are born, who by the grace of the Holy Spirit received in baptism are made children of God, thus perpetuating the people of God through the centuries. The family is, so to speak, the domestic church. In it parents should, by their word and example, be the first preachers of the faith to their children; they should encourage them in the vocation which is proper to each of them, fostering with special care vocation to a sacred state.

### BULLETIN BITES

**"Master, we have worked hard all night and have caught nothing, but at your command I will lower the nets!"**

Fishing is a difficult and dangerous way to make a living. The profits sometimes do not justify the perspiration and the peril. In addition, it is highly unlikely that a man who has spent his life fishing on a small, pear shaped sea in Galilee would take the advice of a carpenter about where and when to lower his nets. That is why Simon's response to Jesus is such a strong statement of faith. When Simon Peter realized that Jesus was calling him to be his disciple he fell to his knees and said, "Depart from me, Lord, for I am a sinful man". When Isaiah heard the Lord, he proclaimed his unworthiness. The Lord asked, "Whom shall I send?" Isaiah responded, "Here I am Lord, send me!" When Cardinal Karol Wojtyla stepped onto the balcony as Pope John Paul II, he said, "Do not be afraid!" Isaiah, Simon Peter and Saint John Paul II are teaching us that being a disciple, a follower of Jesus Christ, is not about being *worthy*. It is about being *willing*. If we wait until we are worthy, we will never begin. If we are willing, we have already begun to follow Jesus.
