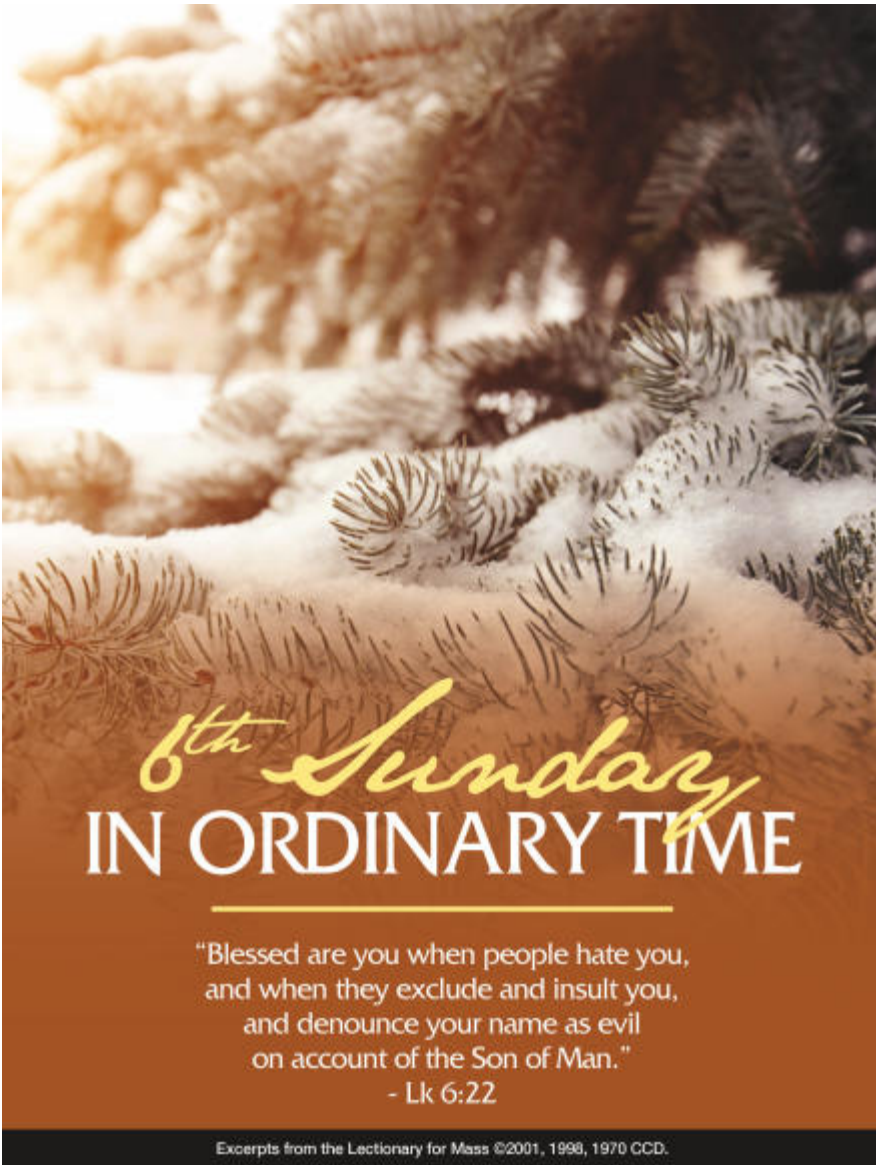

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Over the past year and a half since I have been here the pastoral council and the finance council and I have reflected on the needs of the parish and what might be done to update our parish hall. Along the way we have made a number of small repairs and improvements such as adding screens in all the rooms to take advantage of our "Formed" access for educational purposes, but, there are other items that would take a much bigger investment. There is a strong desire to expand and modernize our kitchen. I do not know if any improvements have taken place since it was first installed. We would also like to have handicap accessible bathrooms, and if we configure the layout well, they could also serve the needs of the church. I recognize that we are lacking in parking, and it seems we would need to extend our parking into the yard a bit. Finally, I would like to provide office space so that one could approach the parish without having to come to my residence. This would also facilitate parish activities that would not depend completely upon the pastor. Hopefully in a few weeks we will have enough materials in place to present to the whole parish for feedback. I would invite you to lift up in prayer our parish's efforts toward this and all of our ministries here.

BULLETIN BITES

"And raising his eyes toward his disciples, he said: Blessed . . ."

Imagine that people from Jerusalem, other parts of Judea and from towns near the Mediterranean Sea are gathered on the slopes of the hills rising out of the northwest shore of the Sea of Galilee. They heard about Jesus and came to listen to him. Imagine there was a stenographer sitting next to Jesus writing down everything he said. Well, there were people gathered on the hillside, but there was no one writing down everything Jesus said. The people on the hillside and in other places, on other occasions, heard the same thing and more from Jesus. They came to hear him because they had also heard that his life matched his message. He did not teach others to do what he was not doing himself. That made him different from the High Priest, Sadducees, Pharisees, and scribes. There were no newspapers, radio, television, videos, or social media to spread the teaching of Jesus. People went home and shared what they heard with their family and village. When we imitate Jesus, people may ask why we do that. Then we can tell them about Jesus.
