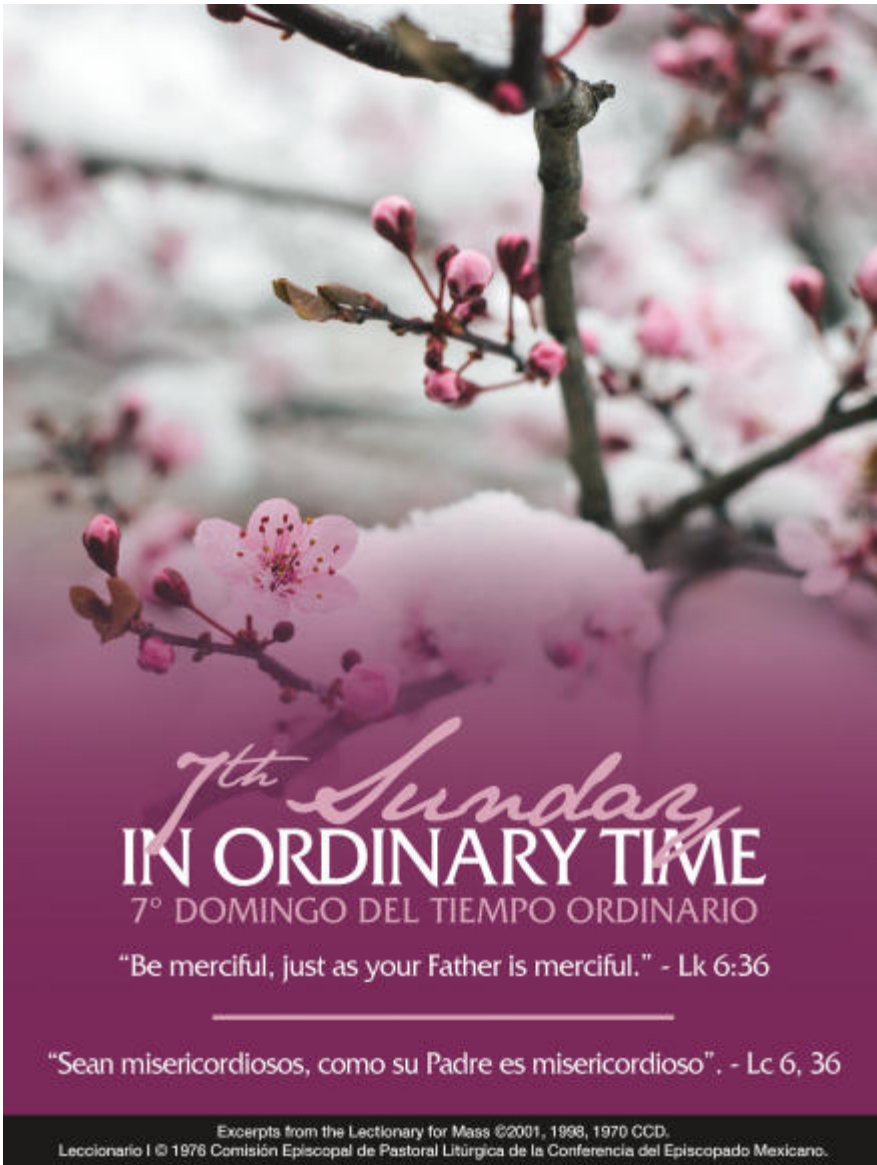

This past week bishops from around the world have gathered for a summit regarding protection of children from sex abuse. Though it is apparently neither a Council nor a Synod, it is still an important gathering. I would ask your continued prayers for the Church as the Bishops work toward a safe environment globally.

Recently I had the chance to get a few seeds sown in preparation for the spring. This is a pleasant time of the year as we look forward to plants coming out of their dormant state and the life that is so evident around us. I know farmers are thinking similarly about their fields. We all have some part in the stewardship of our environment. That is part of the thrust of Pope Francis's document a few years back, "Laudato si." I have been reading that document recently and it helps in reflection on our own circumstances here. Hopefully you have given some reflection on our environment. But how has that reflection intersected with our faith? I find that to be an important topic for us, and I would like to offer a study of the document during Lent with particular focus on our environment here. As we pray, fast, and give alms during that holy season, we can also reflect in humility about our stewardship of our environment with a particular focus on the poor.

### BULLETIN BITES

**"Do to others as you would have them do to you."**

By today's standards, the people who followed and listened to Jesus were poor and worked very hard to provide a meager existence for themselves and their family. They had no hope of rising above their station or achieving an easier life. They knew the Ten Commandments (Decalogue) and the command God gave Moses to Love God with our whole heart, mind, soul, and strength; and to love our neighbor as ourselves (Great Commandment). However, they lived under the brutal oppression of the Romans and the severe teaching and demands of the Jewish leaders of their day that seemed to rule by "an eye for an eye and a tooth for a tooth". When Jesus told them "love your enemies, do good to those who hate you" and to "Do to others as you would have them do to you" he was reminding them of the Decalogue and the Great Commandment. Despite more than two thousand years of Christianity, much of our world is still about "an eye for an eye and a tooth for a tooth". Jesus is reminding us to "Do to others as you would have them do to you".


