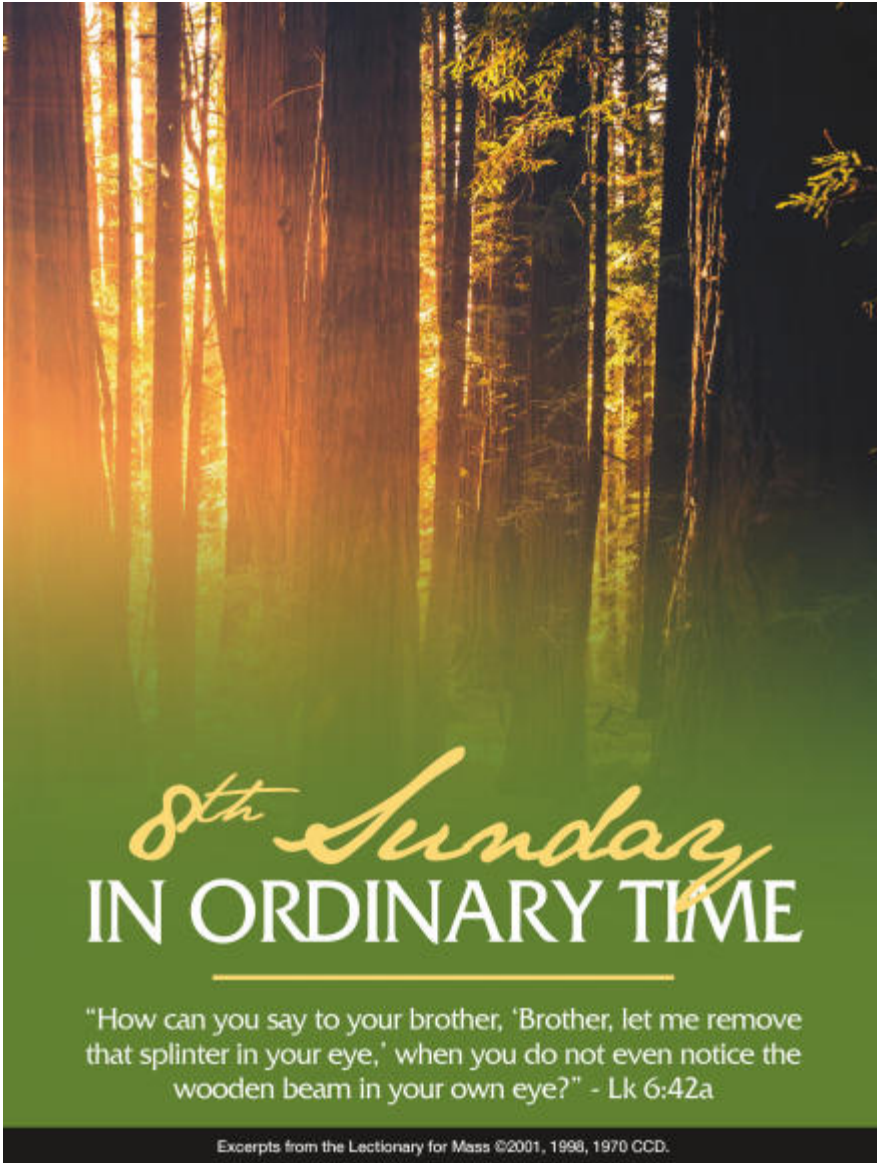

This past week we saw Pope Francis and bishops who are heads of bishops conferences across the world gathered in Rome. I hope you have been accompanying them with prayer. ## SPECIAL COLLECTION

**"Freely you have received; freely give." Matthew 10:8b**

When Jesus first sent His disciples on Mission, He sent them to preach about the Kingdom of God. He commissioned them to speak the message and empowered them to heal the sick, raise the dead, cleanse lepers, and cast out demons. He reminded them (and us),

that these gifts were freely given to them, and they should freely and willingly give these gifts to others. In the Catholic Catechism (no. 166), it says, "you have not given yourself faith as you have not given yourself life. The believer has received faith from others and should hand it on to others." **May we freely give again this year to the Mandeville Sister Diocese Collection.** We empower them with our resources God has freely provided us.

The Diocese, though small, does its part to carry out the mandate of Jesus Christ to "feed the hungry, clothe the naked, and bring the good news to all the people". They do this through not only preaching and teaching, but more so, through the many social programs they conduct their schools, clinics, housing program, orphanages, senior home, and support to persons living with HIV/AIDS, AA Programs, and many more.

The Office of Evangelization is bringing a retreat to Holy Spirit Catholic Church in Bowling Green that will cover topics such as, "Facing our Brokenness," "Encountering the Father's Love," and "Living in Freedom." 
