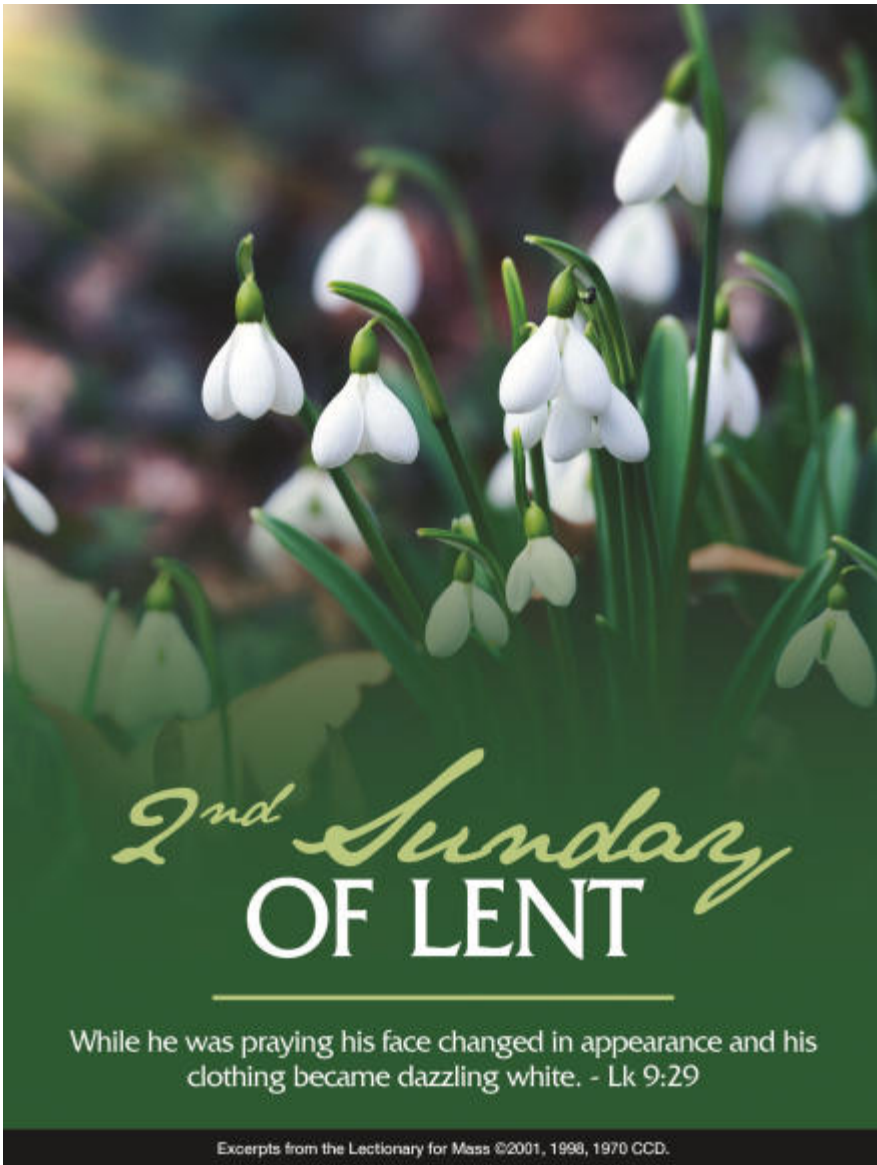

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

A little while back I mentioned an intention to offer a study on the environment using Pope Francis' encyclical letter *Laudato si* which means Praised Be, echoing St. Francis's hymn of praise to God for creation. The document considers the notion of human ecology which we have not necessarily reflected upon much up to this point, but it seems to be a good time to consider it. It also fits well in the context of Lent since it includes in its themes consumption and waste and lifestyles and the common good. My hope is to reflect upon the document in light of what is local to us here in Logan County. I would like to begin on Monday, March 25, the Solemnity of the Annunciation, at 6:30pm. It will be Mondays since that seems to be the only open time, and would likely last an hour and a half and go for about eight weeks extending into Easter. With Monday being my usual day of rest, I may be taking some time on another day of the week while the study continues.

BULLETIN BITES

“This is my chosen Son; listen to him.”

Mount Tabor is a craggy, steep, cone-shaped mountain southeast of Nazareth. There is a church on top of the mountain that commemorates the Transfiguration with chapels full of beautiful paintings, murals and mosaics depicting the event; Jesus with the three disciples, Jesus with Moses and Elijah; and of course, Jesus in dazzlingly white clothes. The artwork is based on the record of the Transfiguration in the Gospels, but is ultimately the product of the imagination of the artist. The real meaning of the Transfiguration, like all Revelation in the Old and New Testaments, is God's love for His creation and His hope that we will be aware of His love for us. Moses conveyed God's commandment that we love God with our whole heart, mind, soul, and strength; and love our neighbor as ourselves. Elijah conveyed God's promise that he would send a Messiah. Jesus revealed himself as our Savior and Lord, our Messiah. Do we believe that?


