Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

As I mentioned before it is that time of the year for the Disciples Response Fund Appeal. Traditionally we have been generous with that appeal, and I ask for your continued generosity. Please take note of the correspondence through the mail directly regarding this, and we have materials available in the church as well. I would also like to call your attention to World Mission Sunday this October 25. As we have given much attention to things close to home, I think it is also very important to look beyond the parish and diocese to the missionary impulse that characterizes the Body of Christ. The Church exists for mission. The term, "apostle" means one who is sent, and so for us who are at home it is important to participate in that aspect of the Church's ministry through our own sacrificial giving.

October is Respect Life Month and the program from the USCCB calls attention in its reflection to the 25th anniversary of the St. John Paul II's *Evangelium vitae*, The Gospel of Life. I remember in seminary reading it with excitement when it first came out. While the culture at the time was undermining life, the document clarified the Church's teaching on life and placed it in the context of the Good News of Jesus. As we look back, we see how the struggle for life to be honored and to be protected as a gift from God penetrates so many aspects of life. The struggle involves sacrifices to make a welcoming environment for life. Selfishness is contrary to this, so we strive therefore to be generous with our time, resources and attention especially to the least among us.

After many months, we meet each other again face to face, not screen to screen. Face to face. This is good! The current pandemic has highlighted our interdependence: we are all connected to each other, for better or for worse. Therefore, to emerge from this crisis better than before, we have to do so together; together, not alone. Together. Not alone, because it cannot be done. Either it is done together, or it is not done. We must do it together, all of us, in *solidarity*. I would like to underline this word today: *solidarity*. As a human family we have our common origin in God; we live in a common home, the garden-planet, the earth where God placed us; and we have a common destination in Christ. But when we forget all this, our *interdependence* becomes *dependence* of some on others — we lose this harmony of interdependence and solidarity — increasing inequality and marginalization; the social fabric is weakened and the environment deteriorates. The same way of acting.


