Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

This weekend is our Disciples Response Fund Commitment weekend. I am sure that you are familiar with the procedures we have for it and how it is put to use at the diocesan level. I would just ask that you be generous with the offering, keeping in mind that the parish does not exist simply as a congregation, but rather as a subdivision of the diocese. And again, World Mission Sunday is coming up on the 25th of October. So I ask you to be generous with the evangelical mission of the whole Church. As peculiar as we may find our life circumstances these days, we still need to look beyond our own concerns and contribute to the spread of the Gospel insofar as we can.

In a recent conversation I spoke of the tension between two expressions: “absence makes the heart grow fonder,” and “out of sight, out of mind.” Sometimes, separation can increase longing and desire and sometimes separation can tend toward not being mindful. I think it is important for us while we are separated from our usual gatherings not to grow numb to the importance of fellowship but rather to look with a more fervent desire for fraternal gatherings and charity toward one another insofar as that is possible.

Tips for parents for catechesis in the home:

- Pray!
- Just do it! And be consistent especially with the time given.
- Include devotions: Rosary; Angelus; Act Contrition; Scripture reading together; Readings for the day are helpful as found in *The Word Among Us*.
- Include Saints in the lessons. (Saints books are helpful, and the Saint of the day.)
- Read the lesson ahead of time.
- Set a time each week.
- Don't be afraid to say “I do not know, but I can find out. I will write it down and ask Father Ken later.”
- Older kids can assist younger kids.

It is therefore time to improve our social love – I want to highlight this: our social love – with everyone’s contribution, starting from our littleness. The common good requires everyone’s participation. If everyone contributes his or her part, and if no one is left out, we can regenerate good relationships on the community, national and international level and even in harmony with the environment (cf. *LS*, 236). Thus, through our gestures, even the most humble ones, something of the image of God we bear within us will be made visible, because God is the Trinity, God is love. This is the most beautiful definition of God that is in the Bible. The Apostle John, who loved Jesus so much, gives it to us. With His help, we can *heal the world* working all together for the *common good*, not only for our own good but for the common good of all.


