Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

This past week we celebrated the funeral Mass for John Higgins. In this time of loss I ask you to keep his family in prayer and pray for the repose of his soul and of all our deceased brothers and sisters.

As our elections are approaching it is an opportune time to revisit a document of the US Bishops, "Forming Consciences for Faithful Citizenship." They have revised it for 2020 with a helpful introductory letter and other changes in the document. It is given in three parts: Forming Consciences for Faithful Citizenship, Applying Catholic Social Teaching to Major Issues, and Goals for Political Life. The first part addresses conscience, prudence and moral choices and four principals of Catholic Social Teaching: dignity, subsidiarity, the common good, and solidarity. The second part applies Catholic Social Teaching to major issues: human life, promoting peace, marriage and family life, religious freedom, preferential option for the poor and economic justice, health care, migration, Catholic education, promoting justice and countering violence, combatting unjust discrimination, care for our common home, communications media and culture, and global solidarity. The third part includes ten goals as priorities to pursue that flow from the previous two sections. An important part to recognize is that discretion is necessary: "Not all issues are equal; these ten goals address matters of different moral weight and urgency. Some involve intrinsically evil acts, which can never be approved. Others involve affirmative obligations to seek the common good." The document offers a guide to evaluating the issues at hand. Religious Education

Tips for parents for catechesis in the home:

- Pray!
- Just do it! And be consistent especially with the time given.
- Include devotions: Rosary; Angelus; Act Contrition; Scripture reading together; Readings for the day are helpful as found in *The Word Among Us*.
- Include Saints in the lessons. (Saints books are helpful, and the Saint of the day.)
- Read the lesson ahead of time.
- Set a time each week.
- Don't be afraid to say "I do not know, but I can find out. I will write it down and ask Father Ken later."
- Older kids can assist younger kids.

Contemplation, which leads us to an attitude of care, is not a question of looking at nature from the outside, as if we were not immersed in it. But we are inside nature, we are part of nature. Rather, it is done from within, recognizing ourselves as part of creation, making us protagonists and not mere spectators of an amorphous reality that is only to be exploited. Those who contemplate in this way experience wonder not only at what they see, but also because they feel they are an integral part of this beauty; and they also feel called to guard it and to protect it. And there is one thing we must not forget: those who cannot contemplate nature and creation cannot contemplate people in their true wealth. And those who live to exploit nature end up exploiting people and treating them like slaves. This is a universal law. If you cannot contemplate nature it will be very difficult for you to contemplate people, the beauty of people, your brother, your sister.

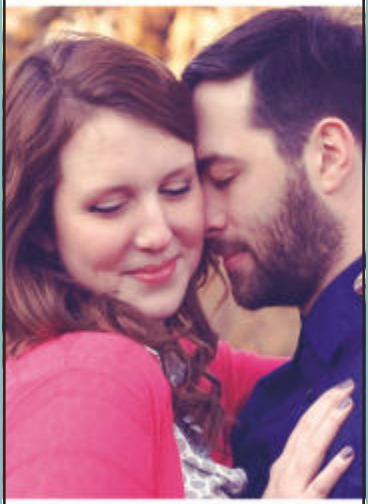
